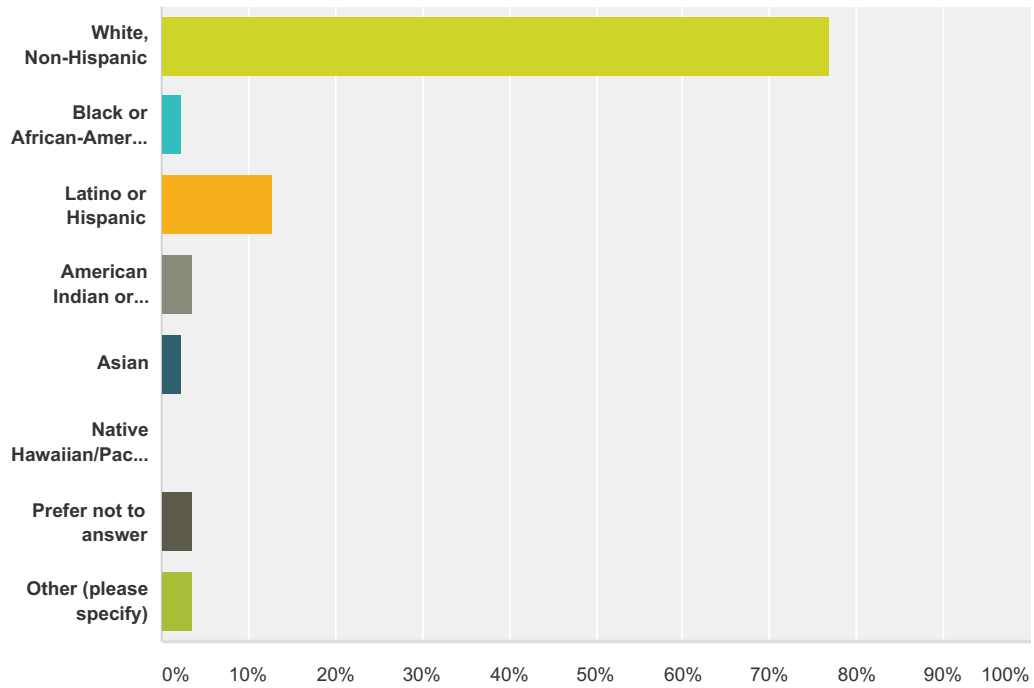

Q9 Within the last two years, have you received personal psychotherapy?

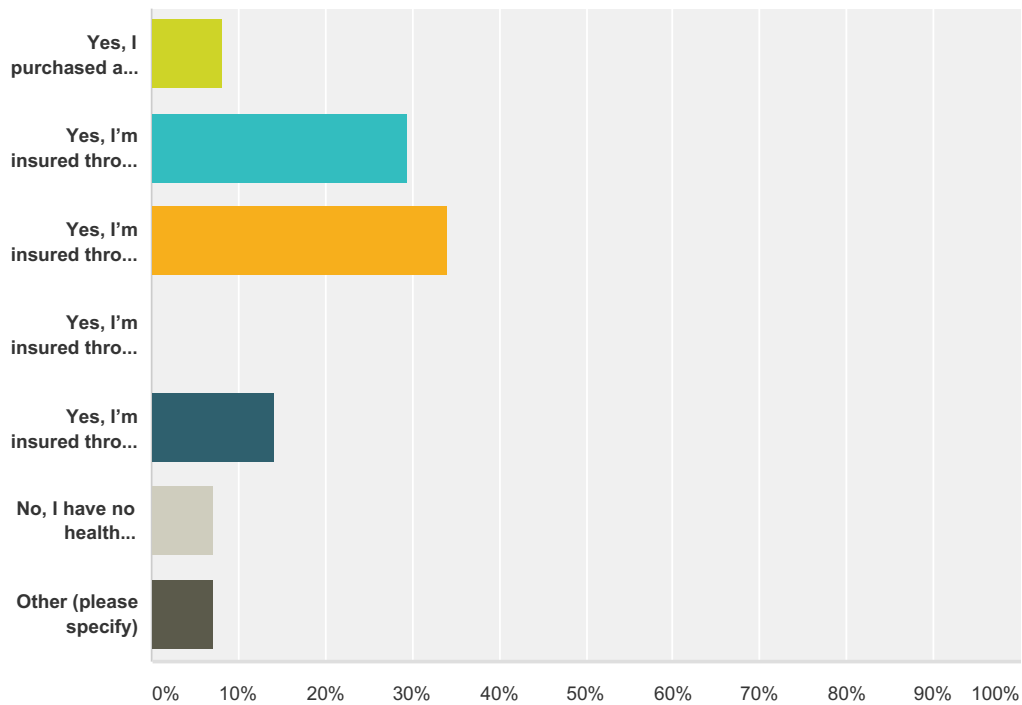

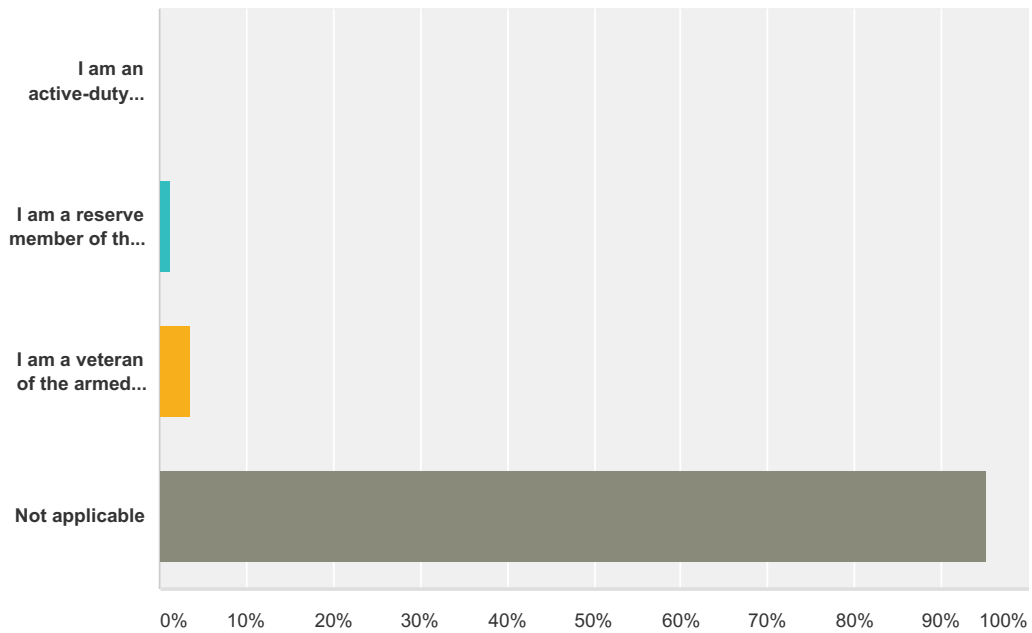

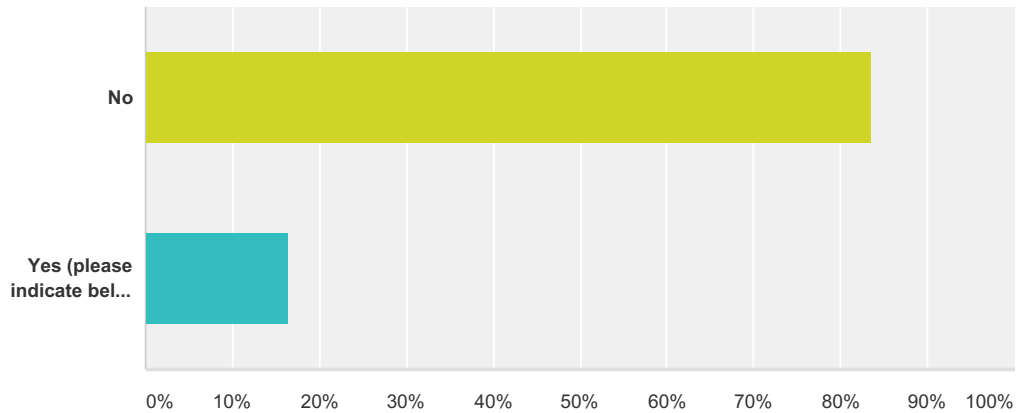

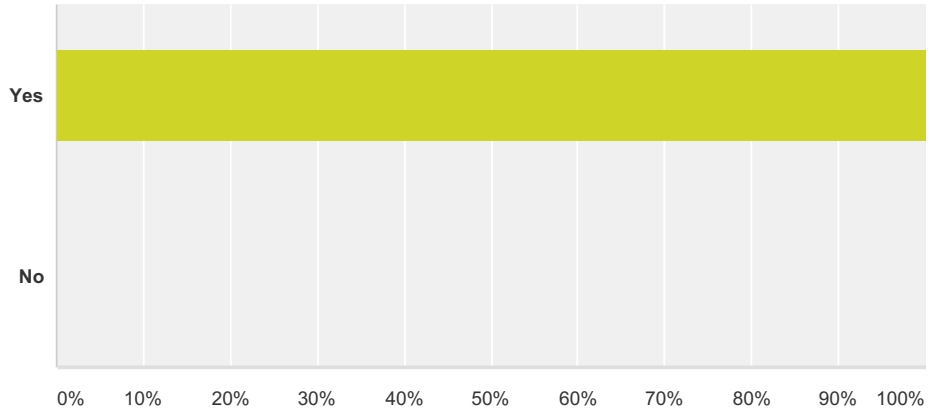

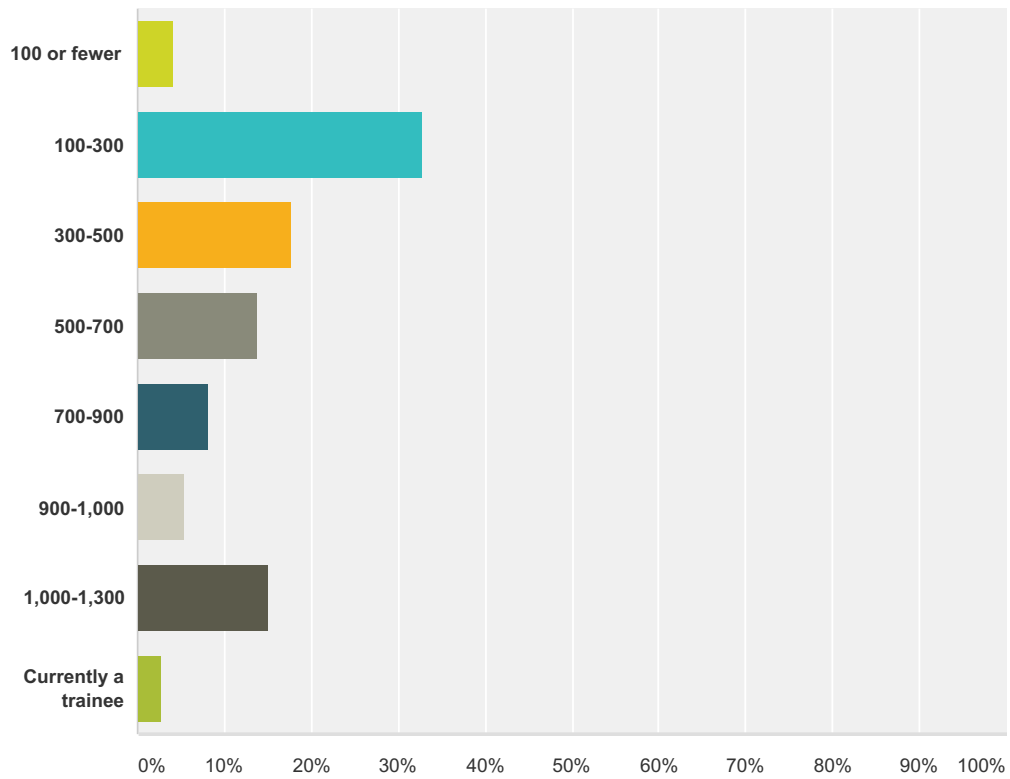

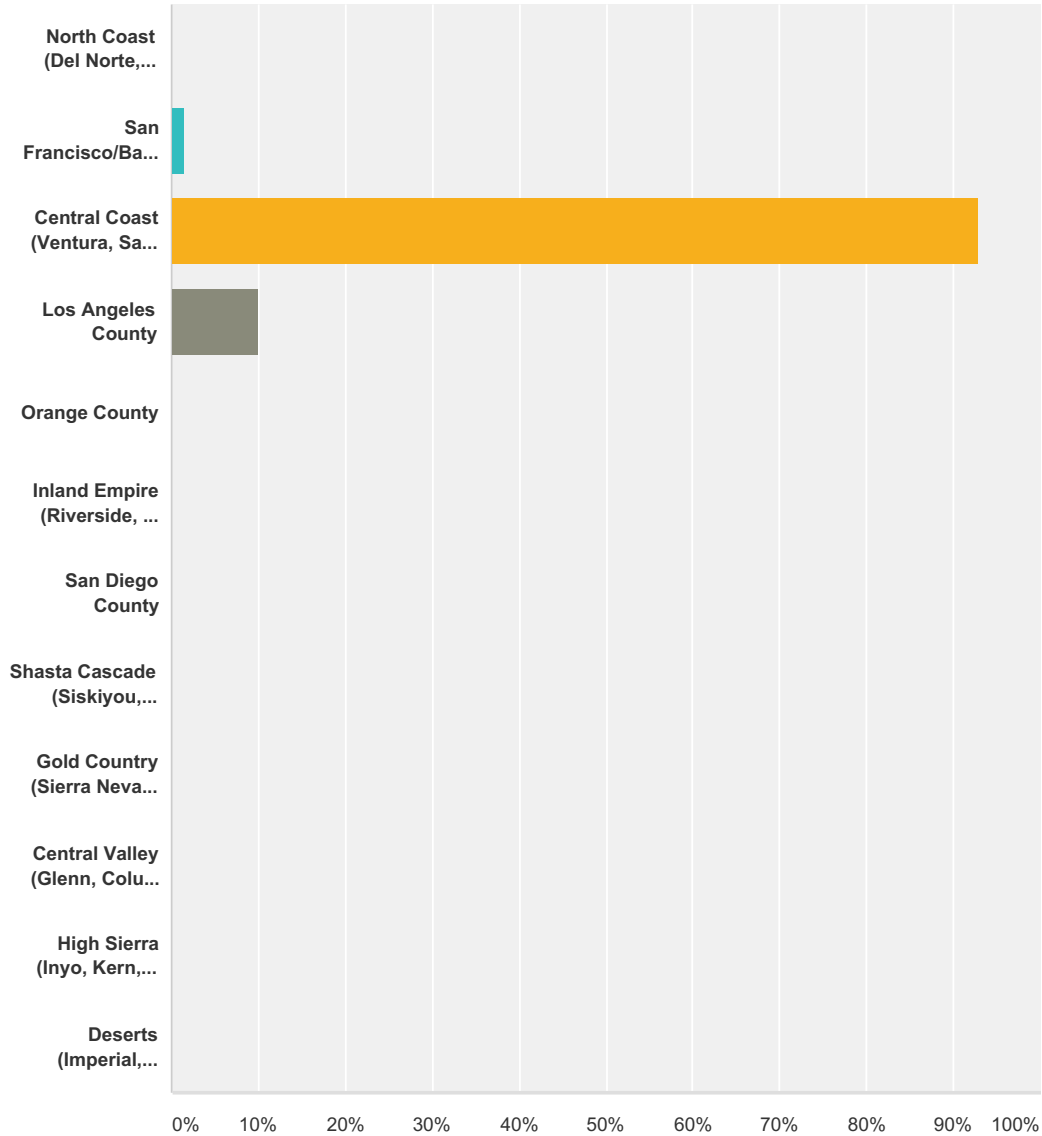

Q20 Do you believe you have sufficient educational training to treat culturally diverse patients?

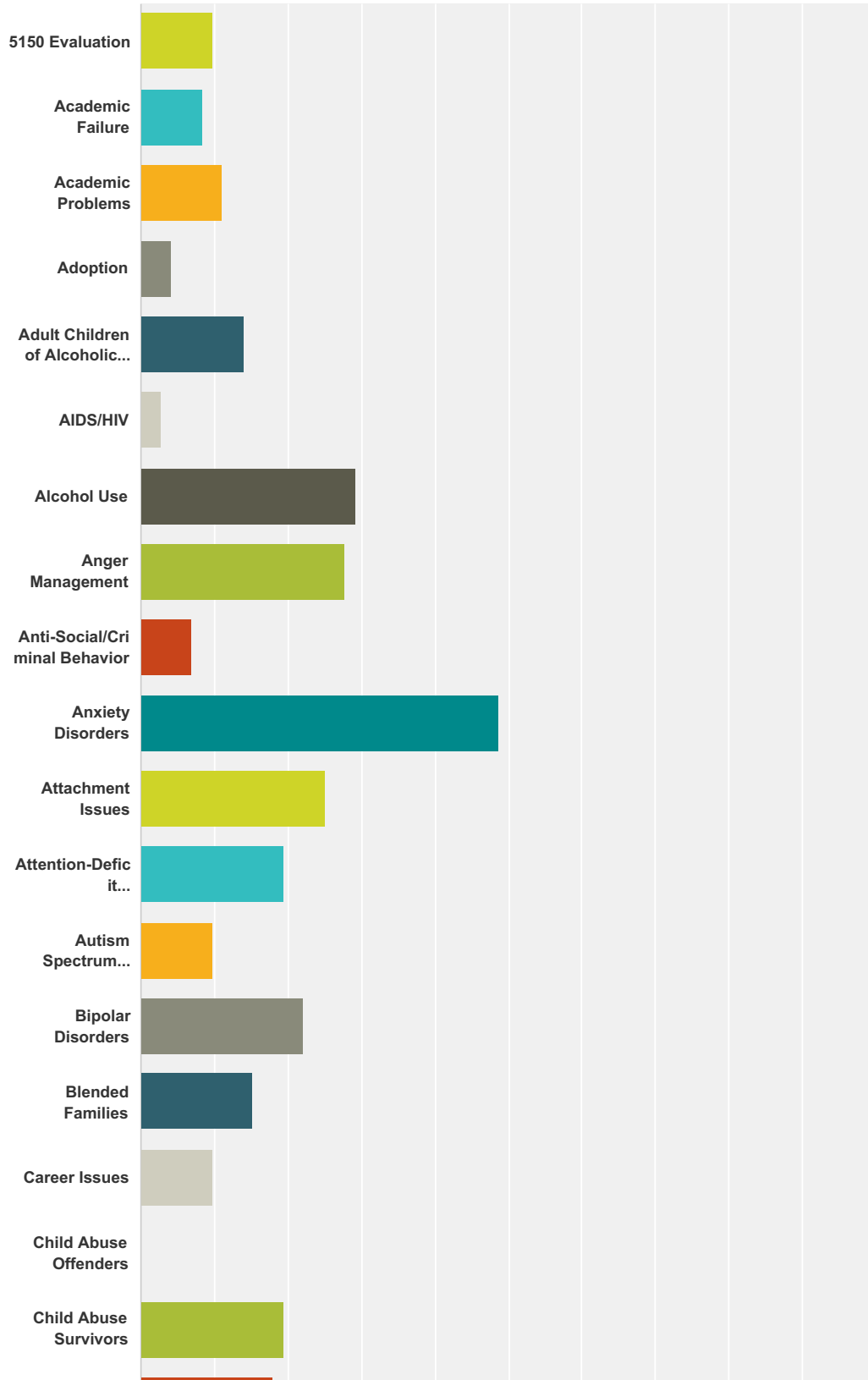

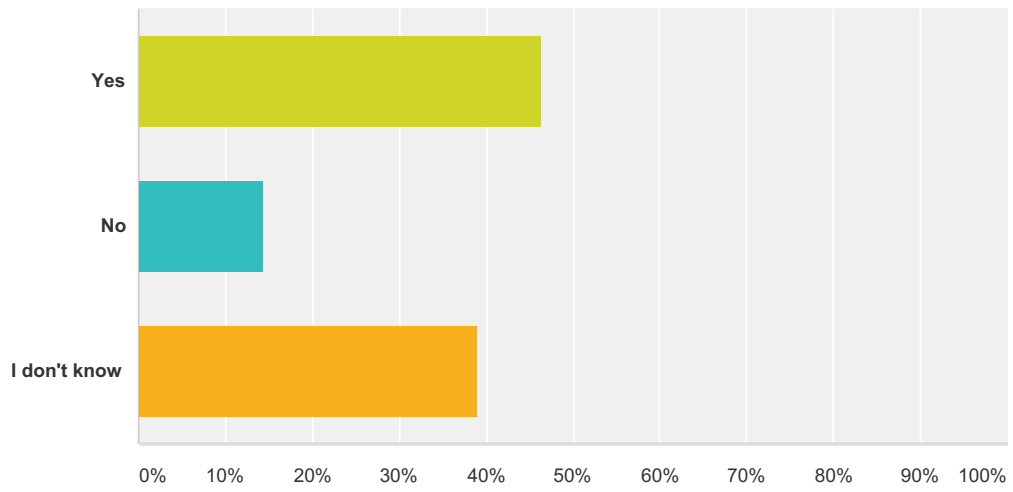

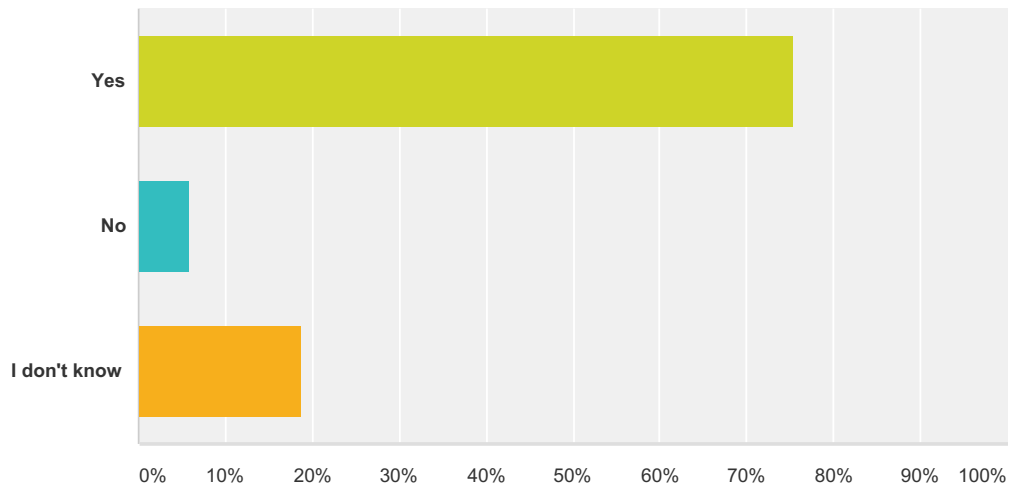

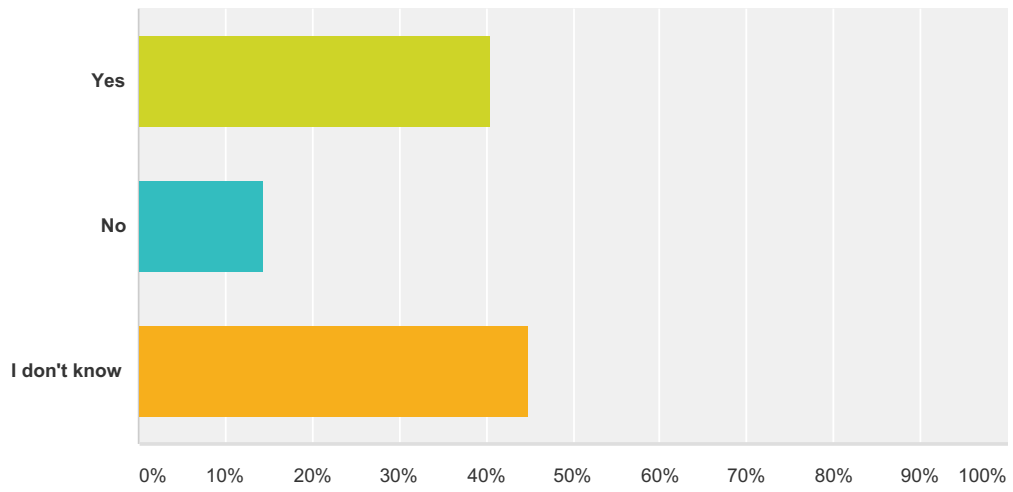

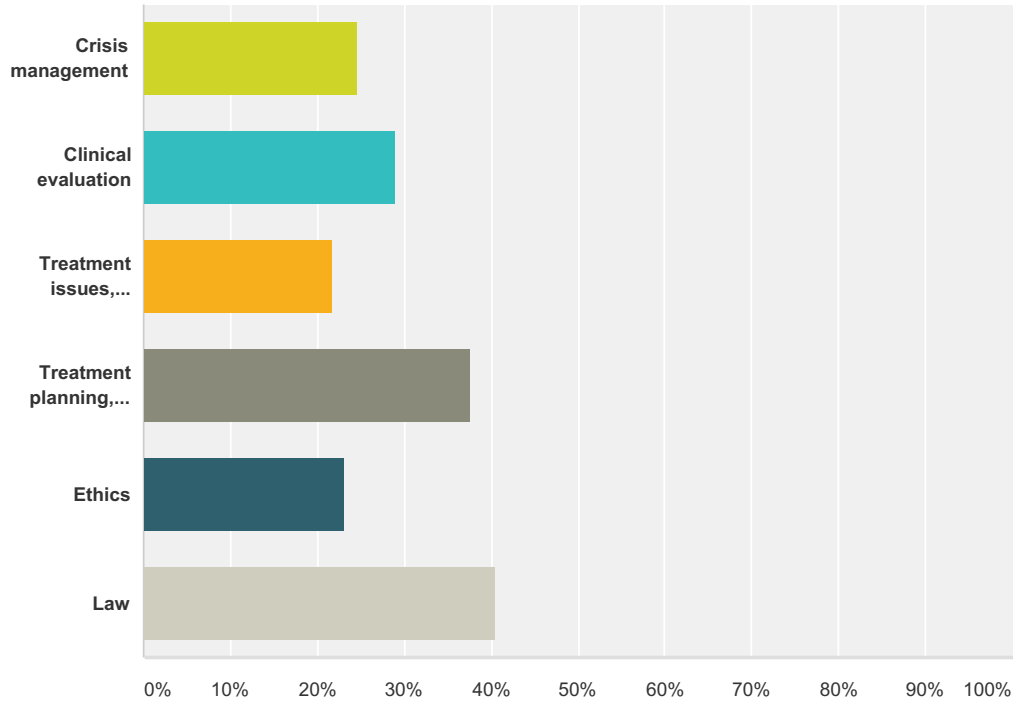

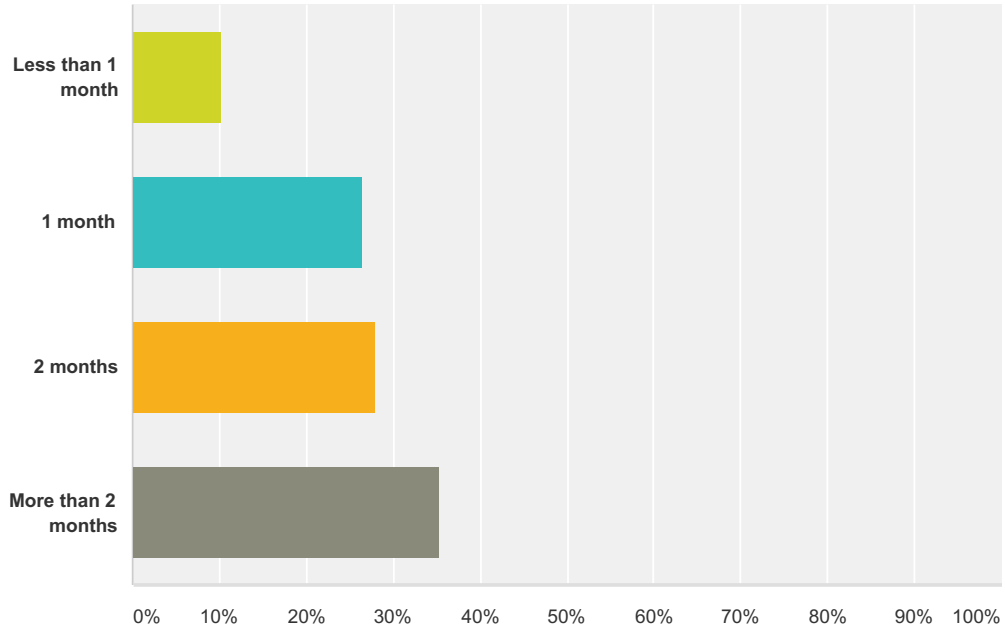
