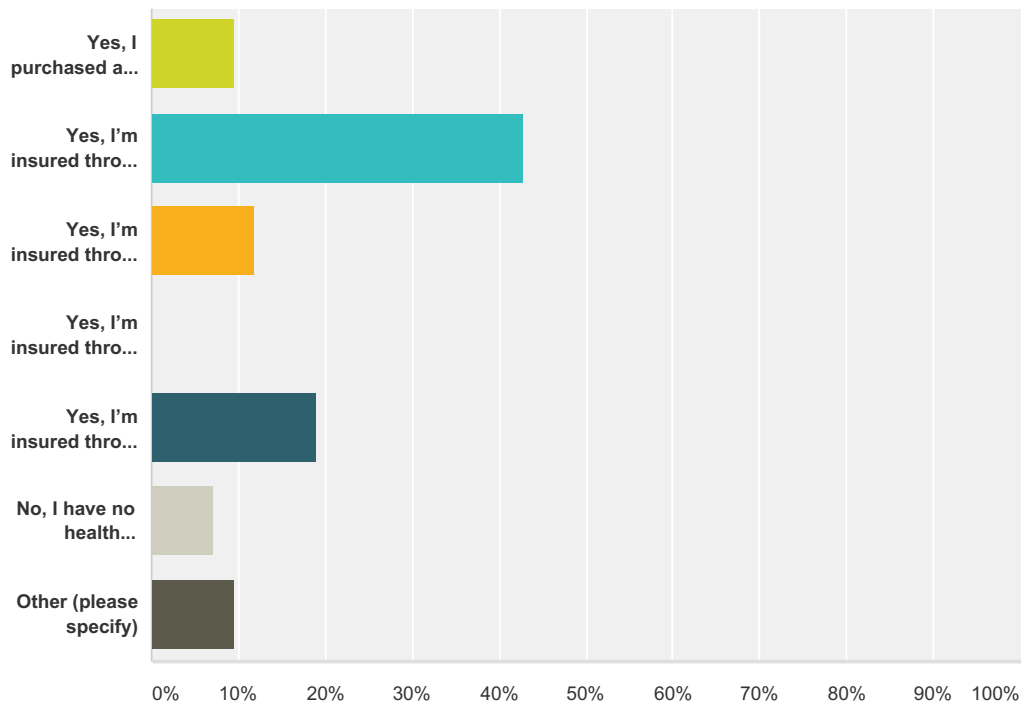

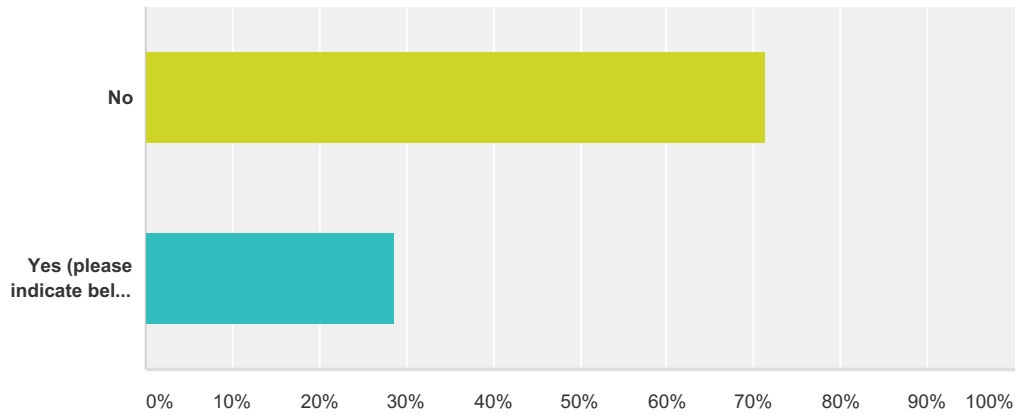

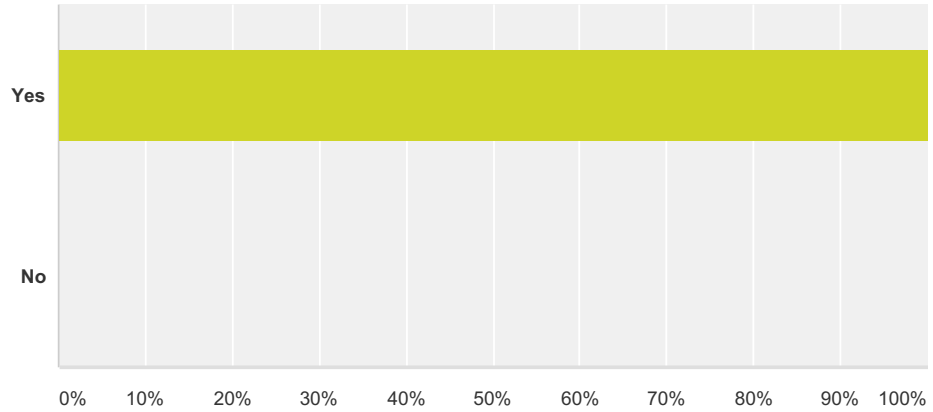

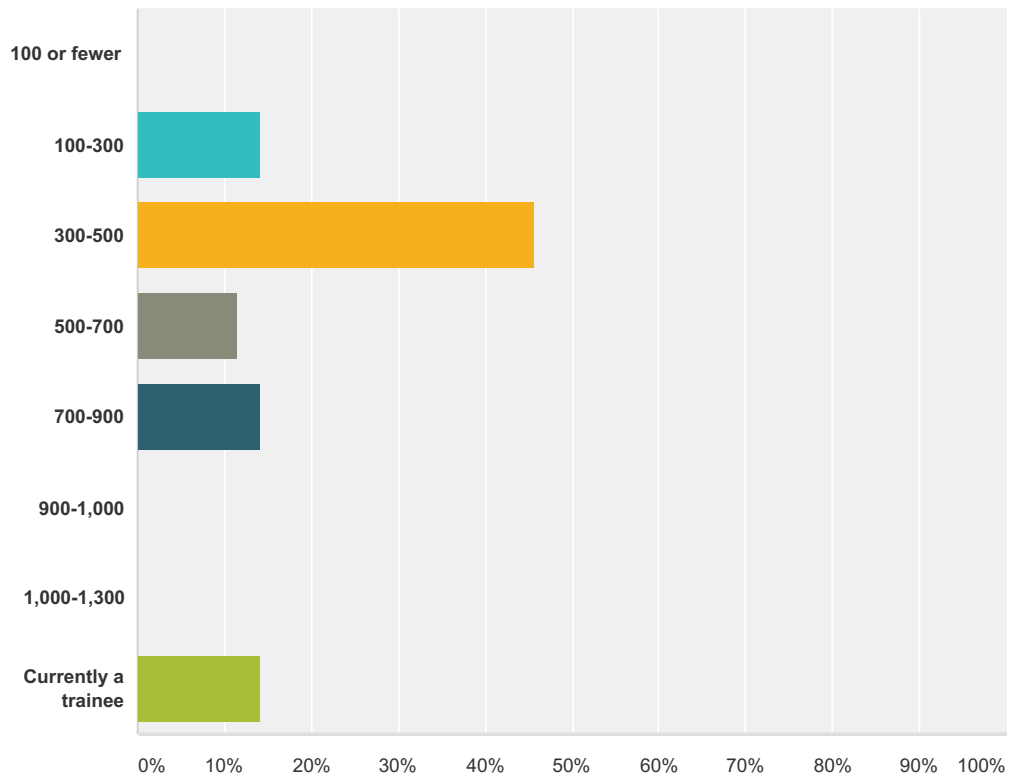

Q20 Do you believe you have sufficient educational training to treat culturally diverse patients?

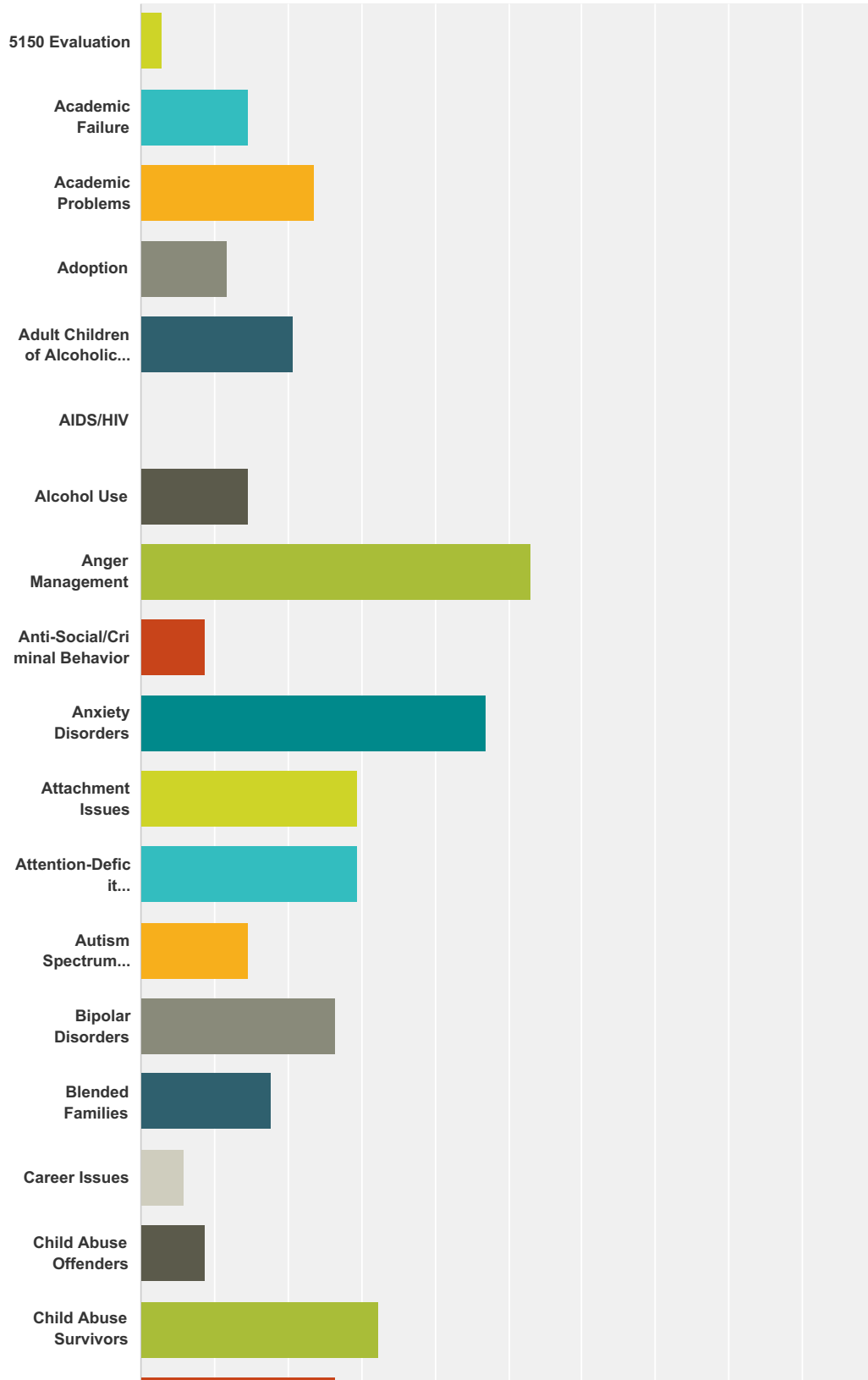

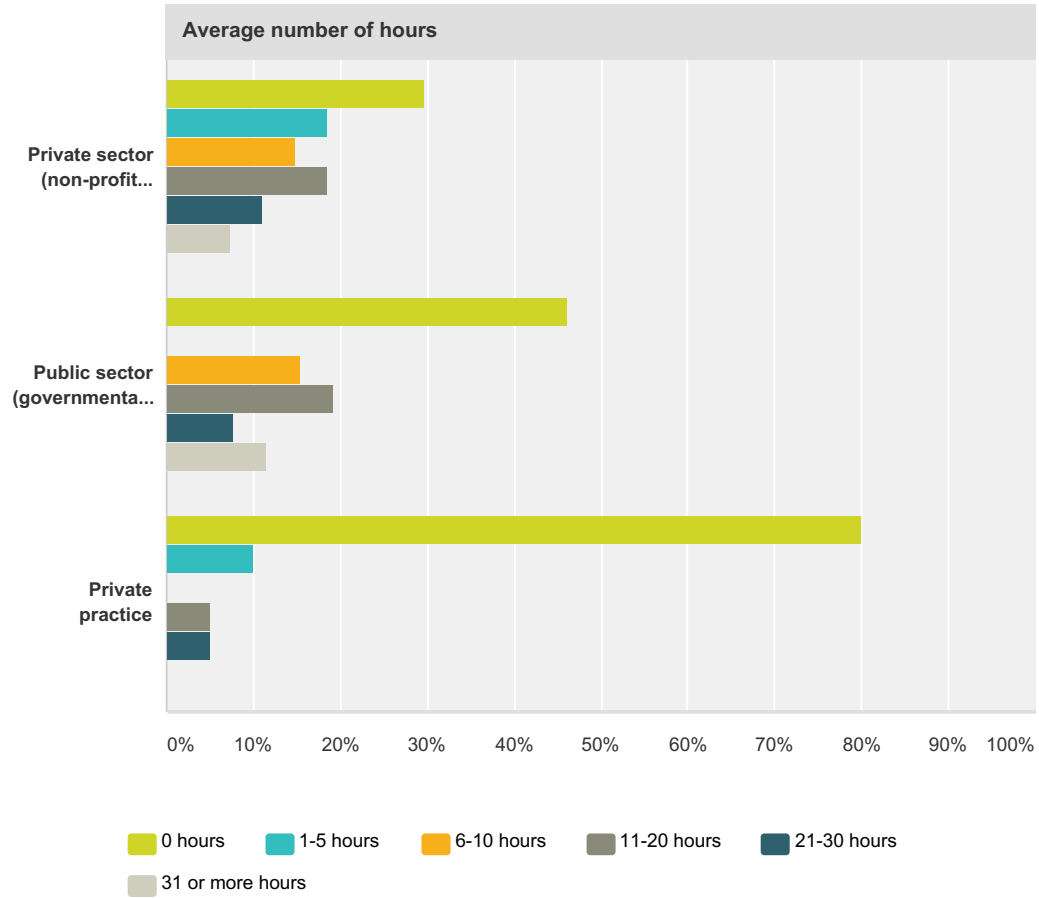

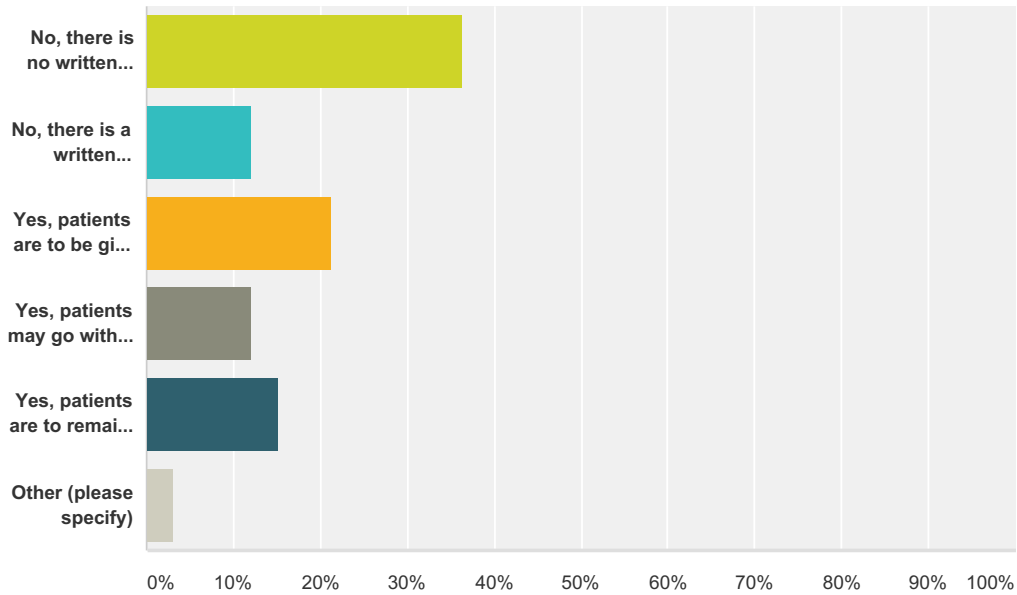

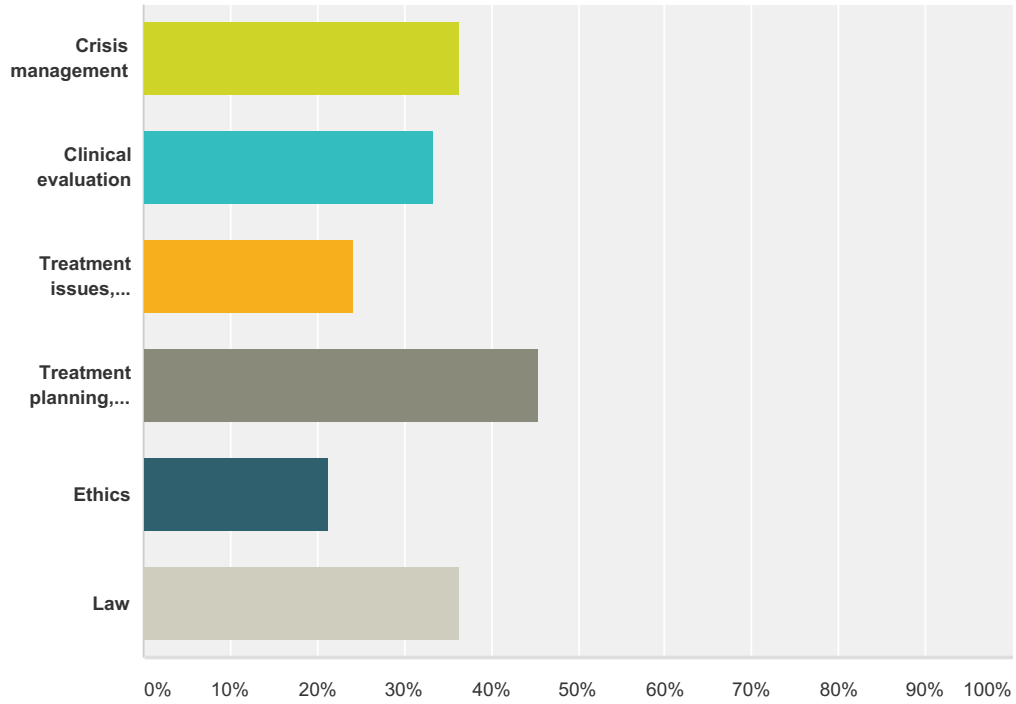

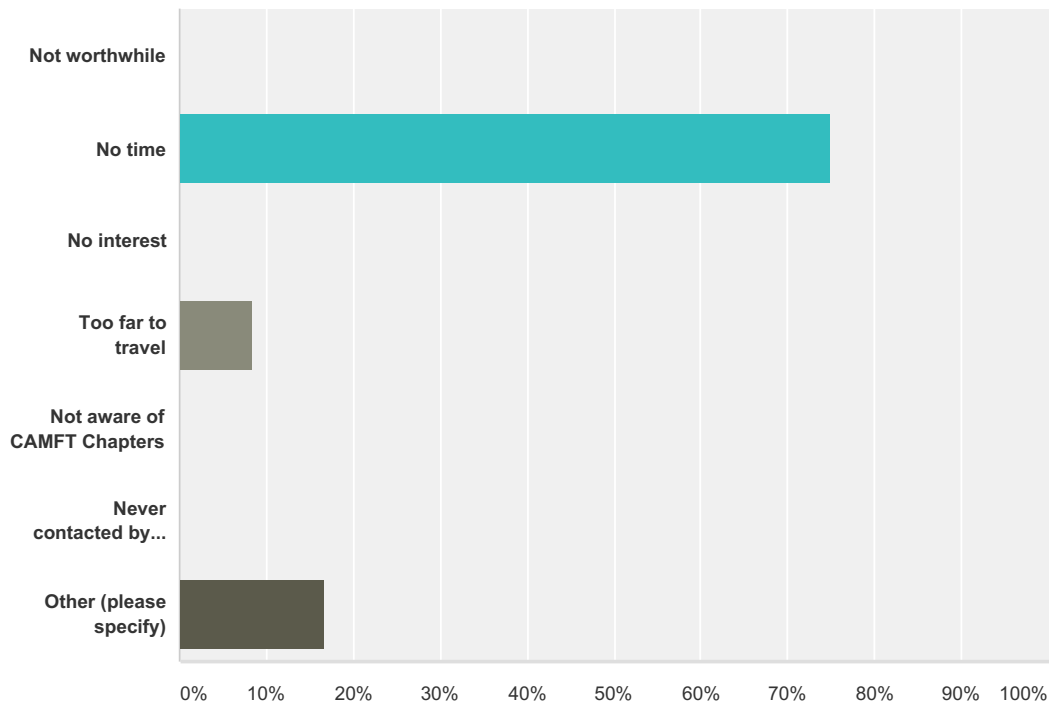
