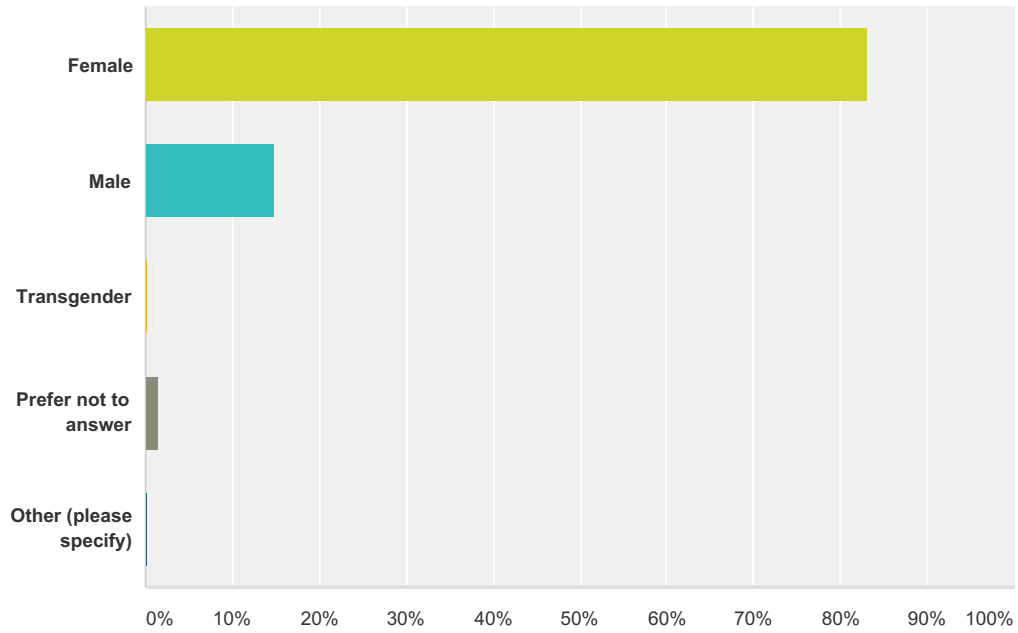

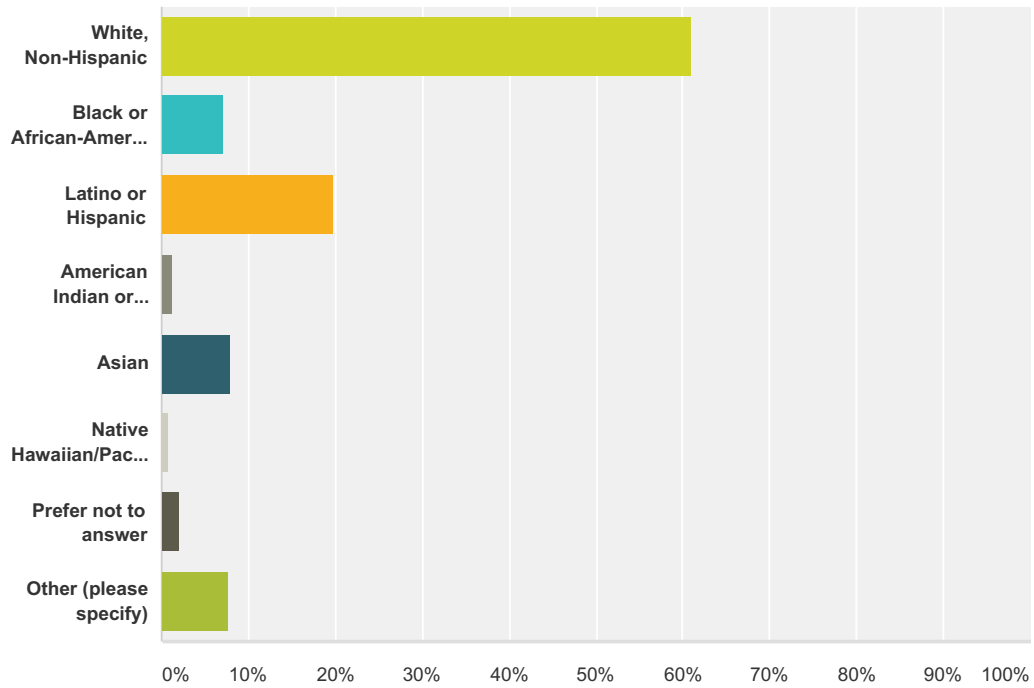

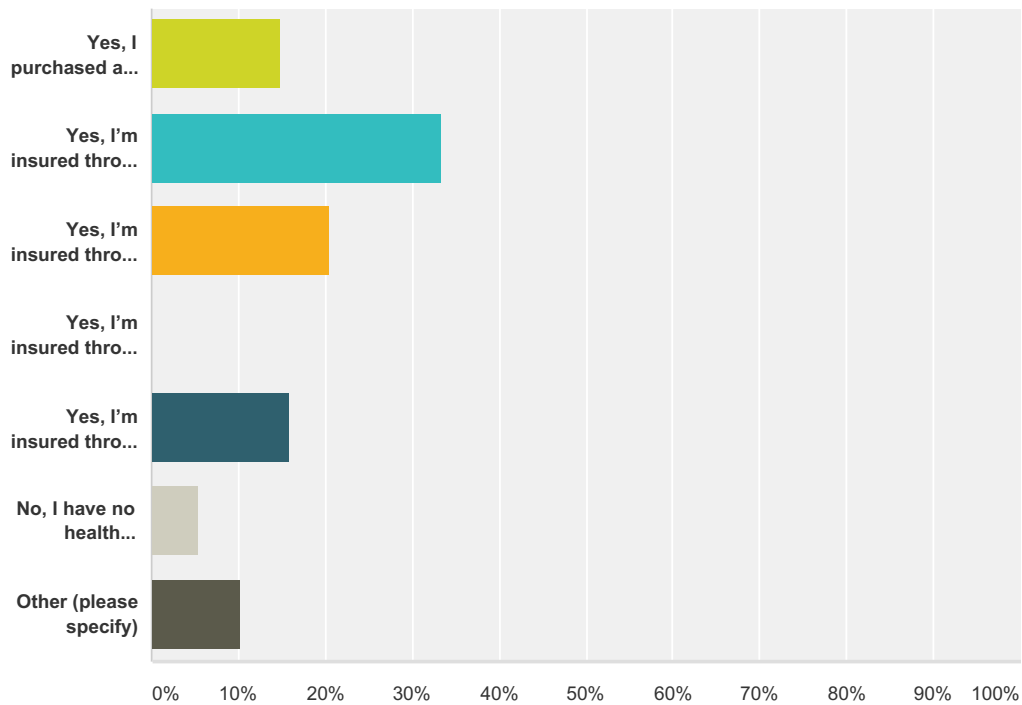

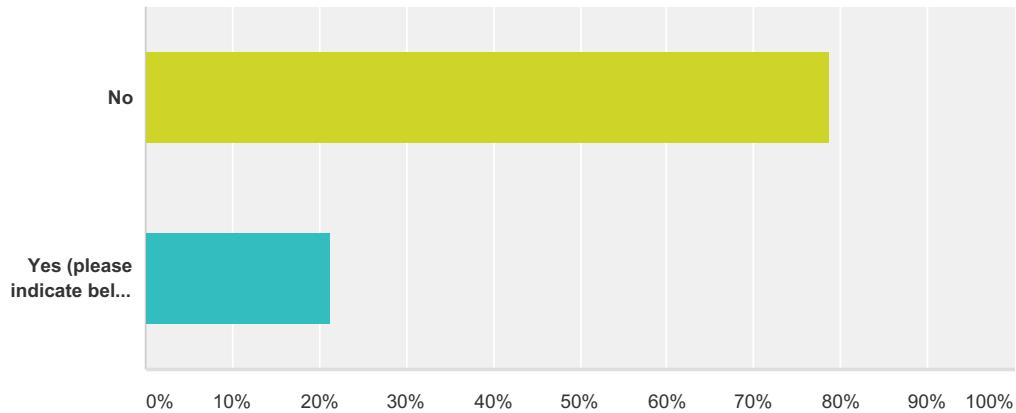

Q37 Do you believe your supervisor has sufficient education, training, and experience to adequately provide supervision?

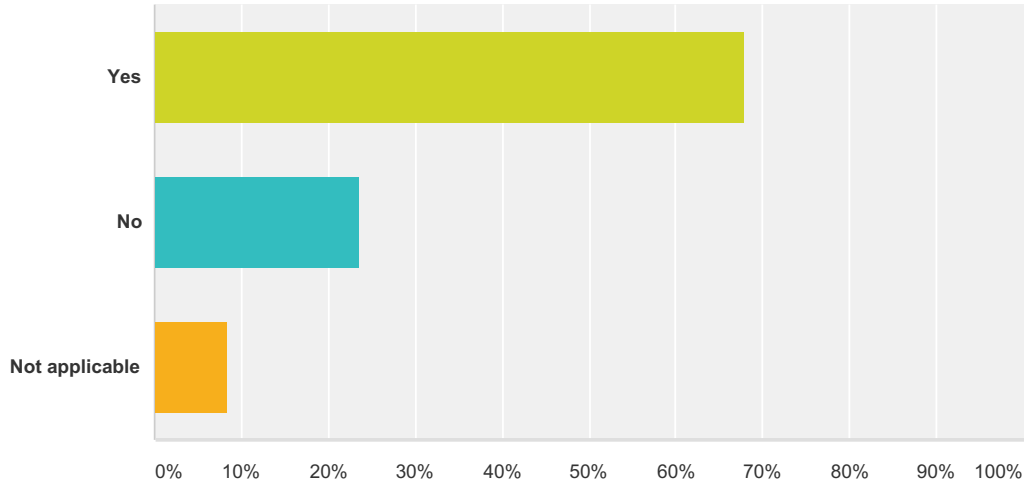

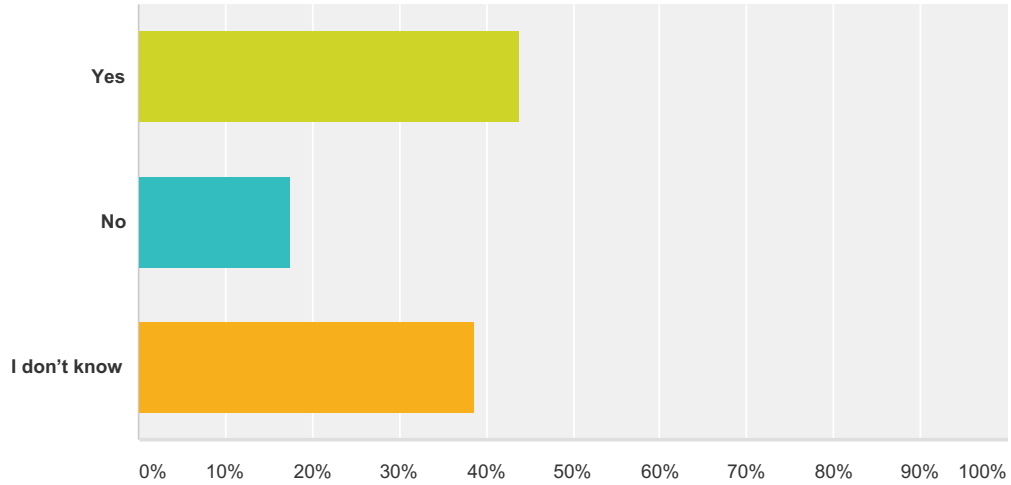

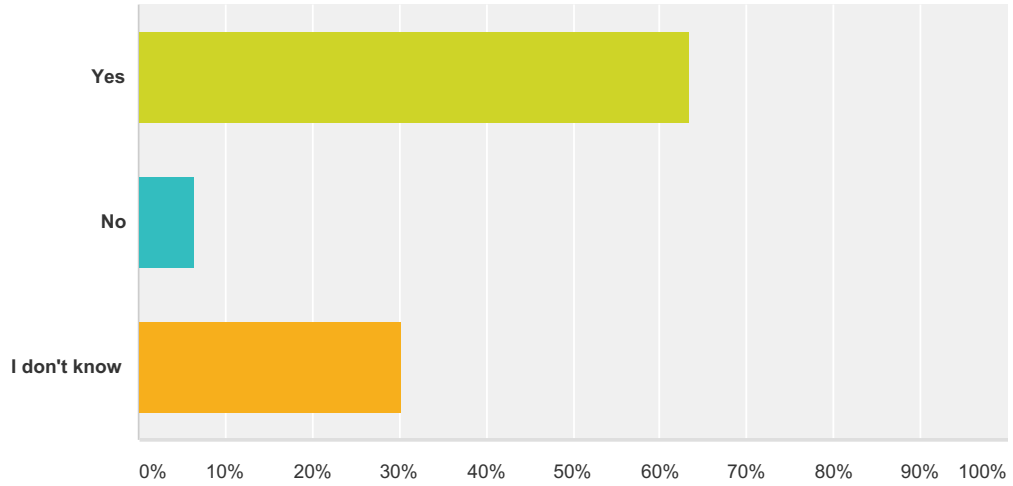

Q40 Once you are licensed do you plan to maintain or work at a private practice setting?

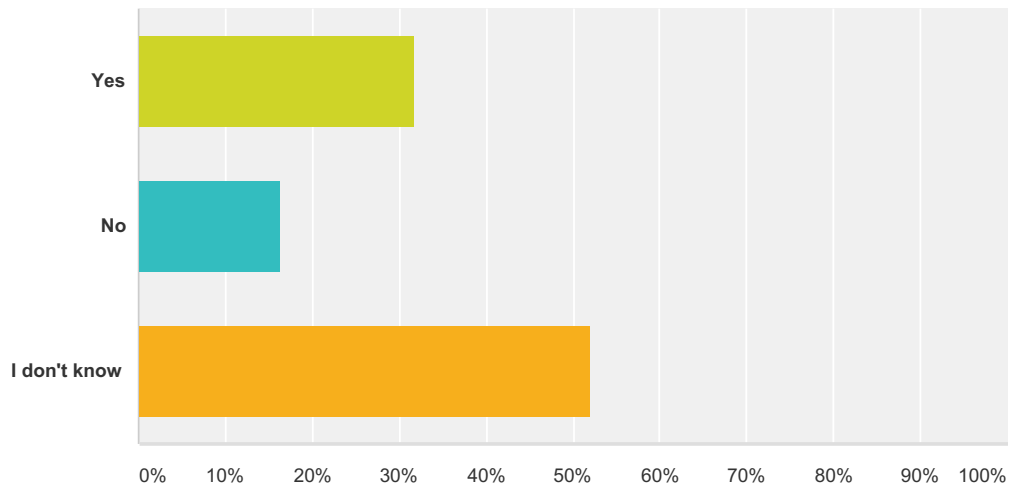

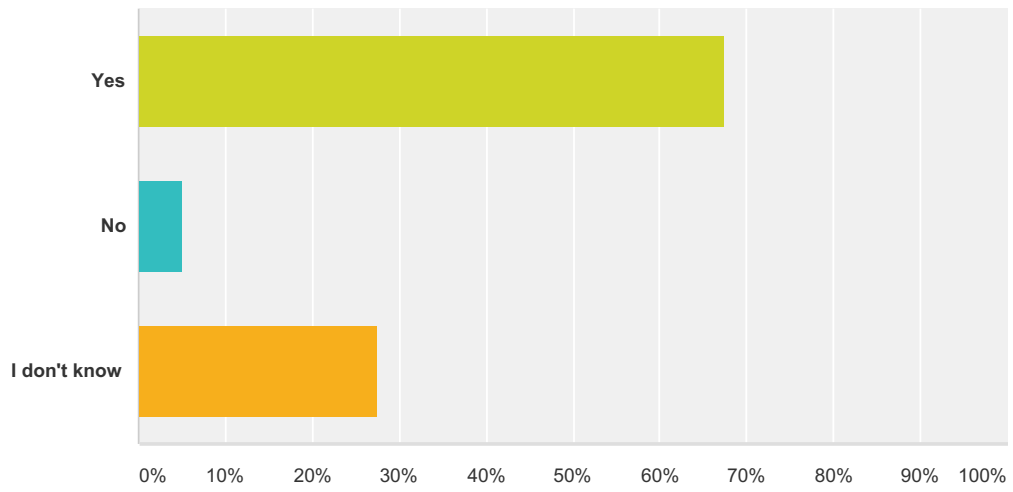

Q42 If MFTs could accept Medicare clients, would you work with Medicare clients?

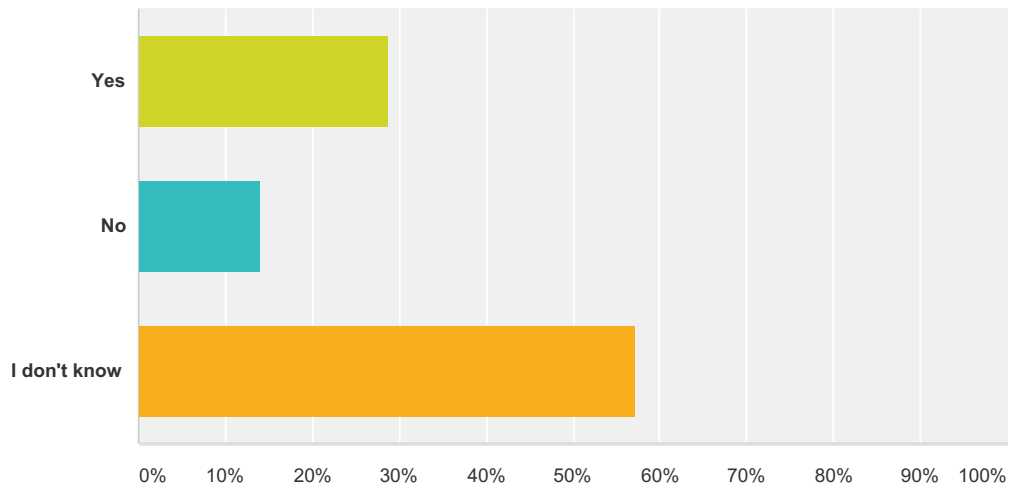

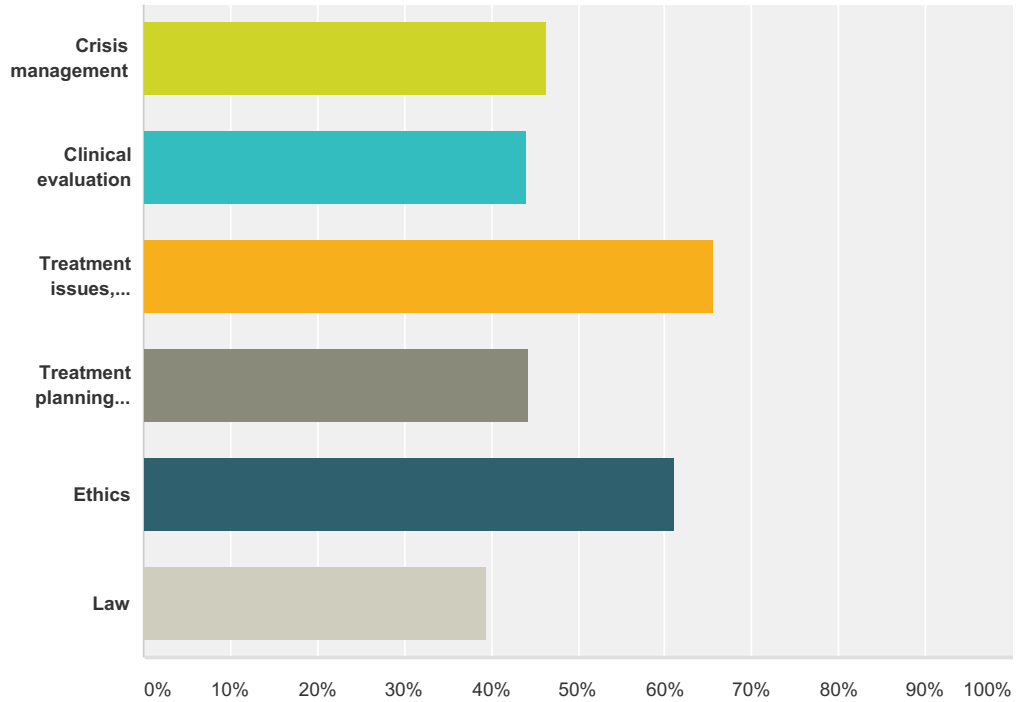

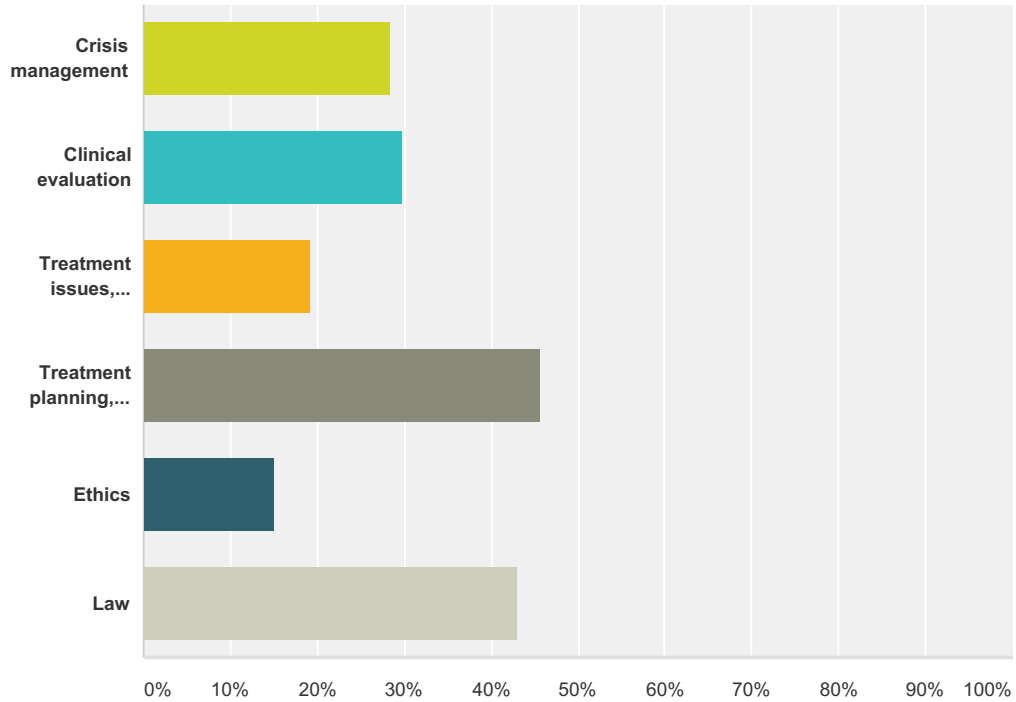

Q45 In which subject area do you feel least prepared for the licensing exams? (Check all that apply)

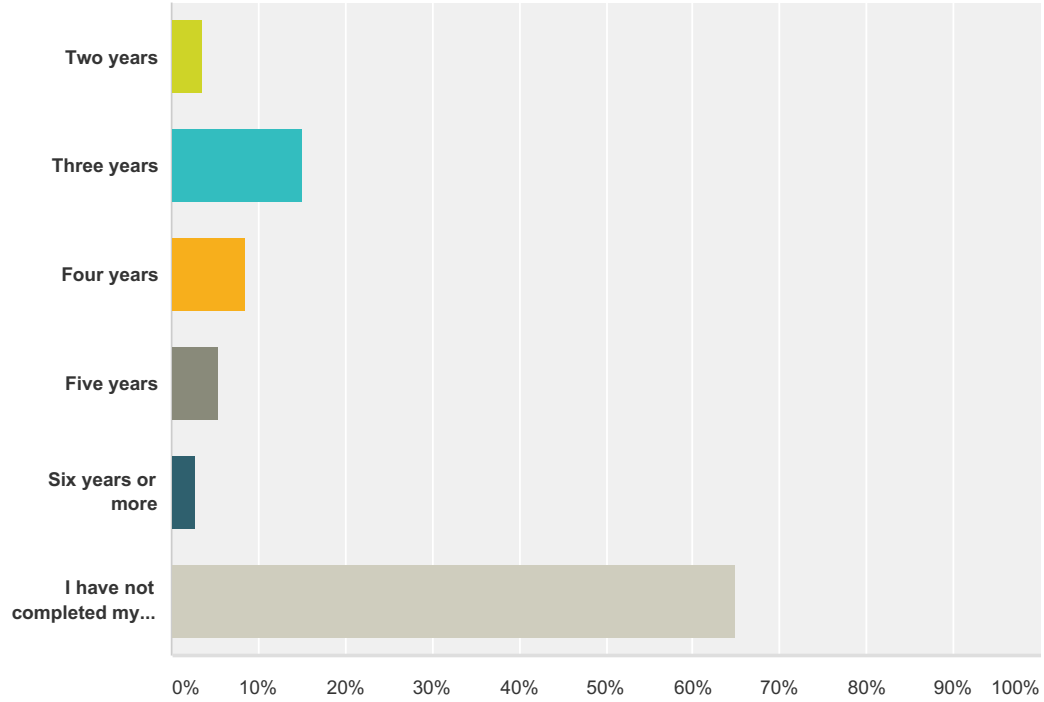

Q46 How many years did it take you to complete your hours of experience (including traineeship)?

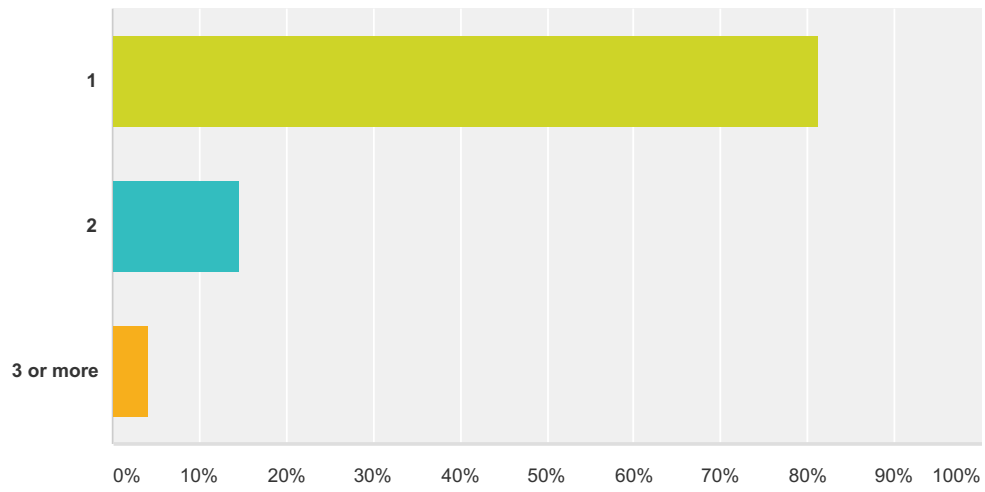

Q47 How many intern registration numbers have you had?

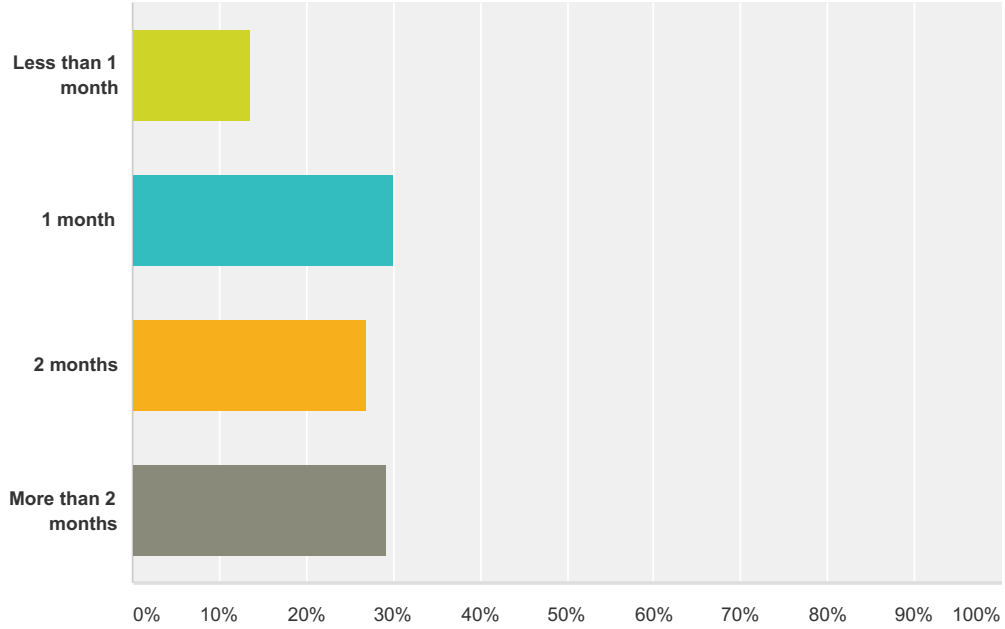

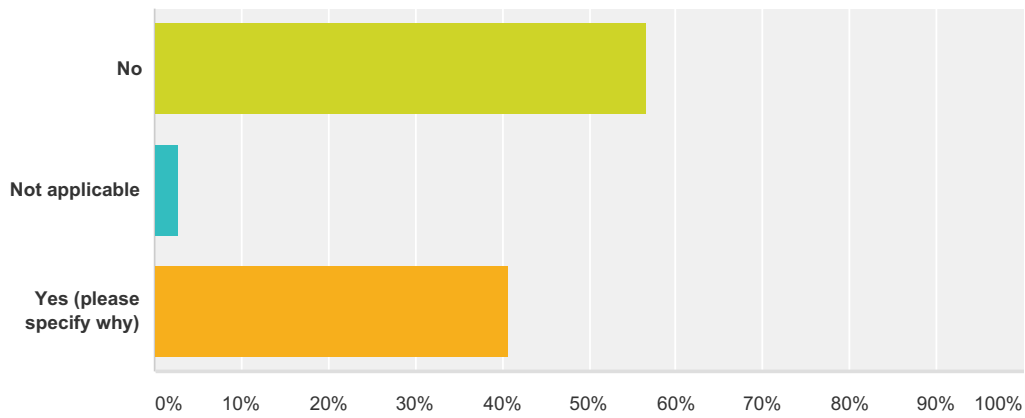

Q51 Are you reimbursed by the health plans for your services?

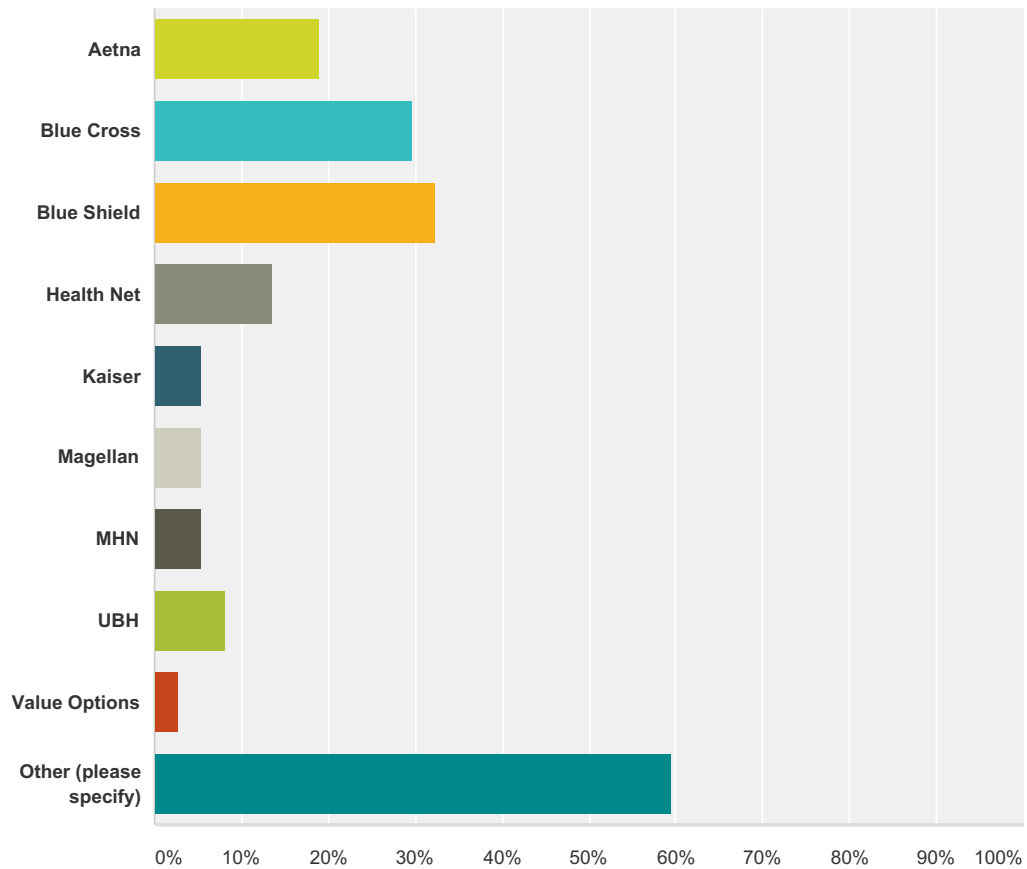

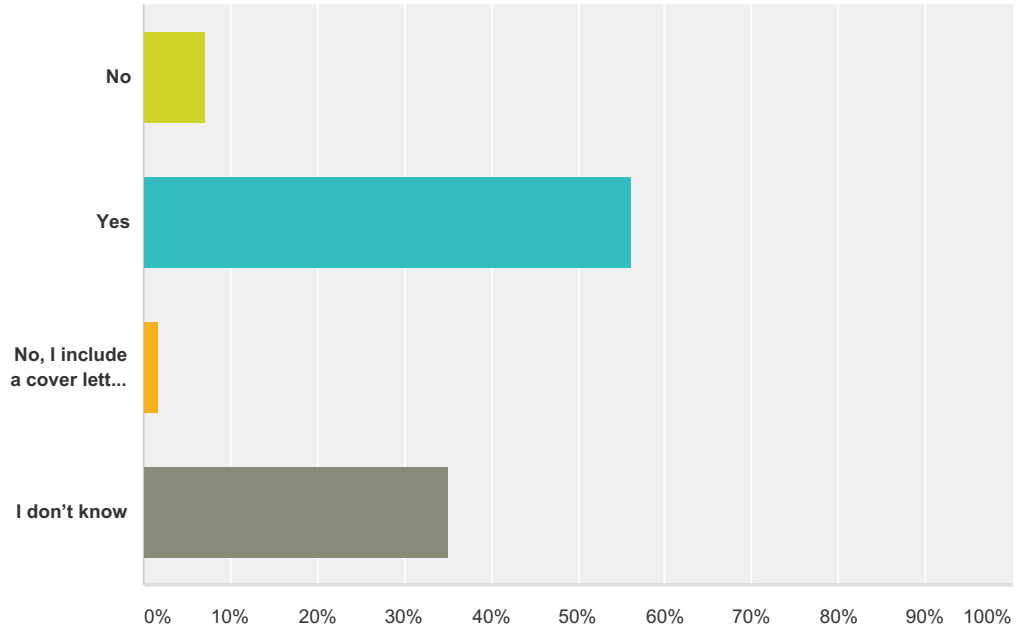

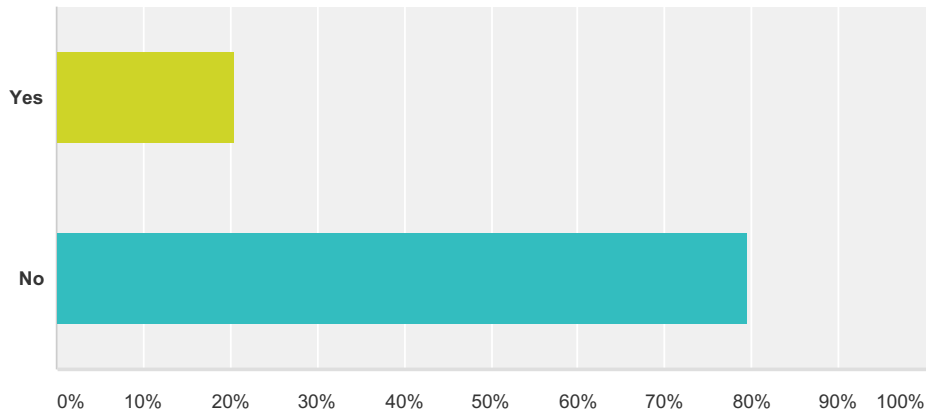

Q54 Do you advertise your professional services?

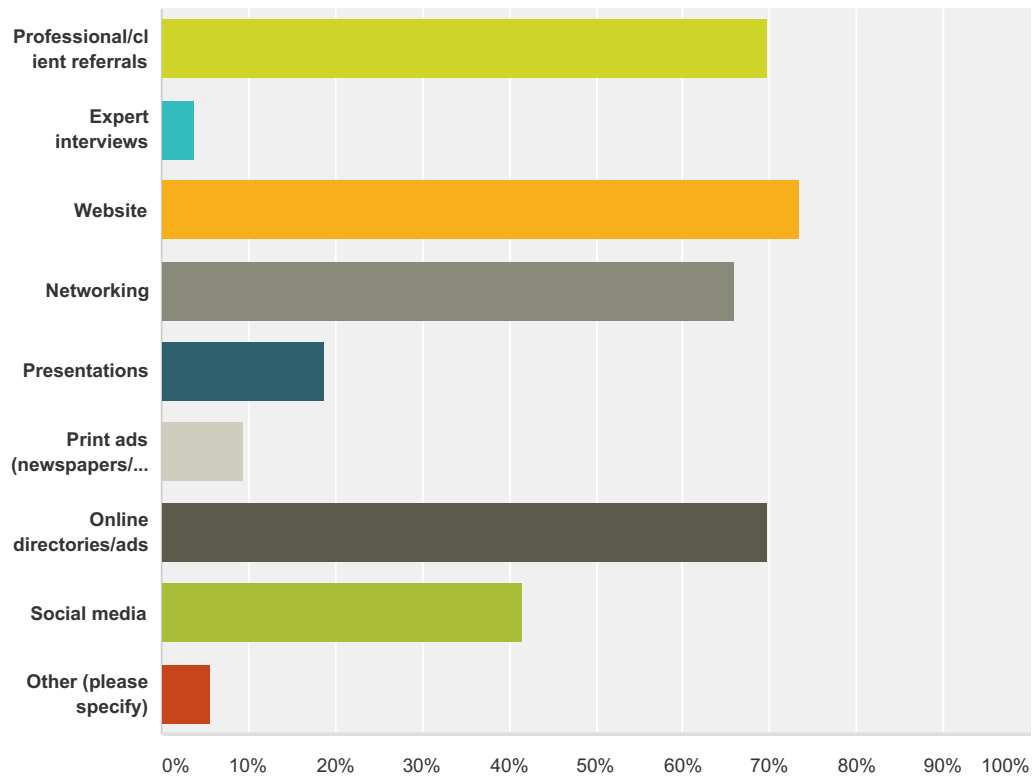

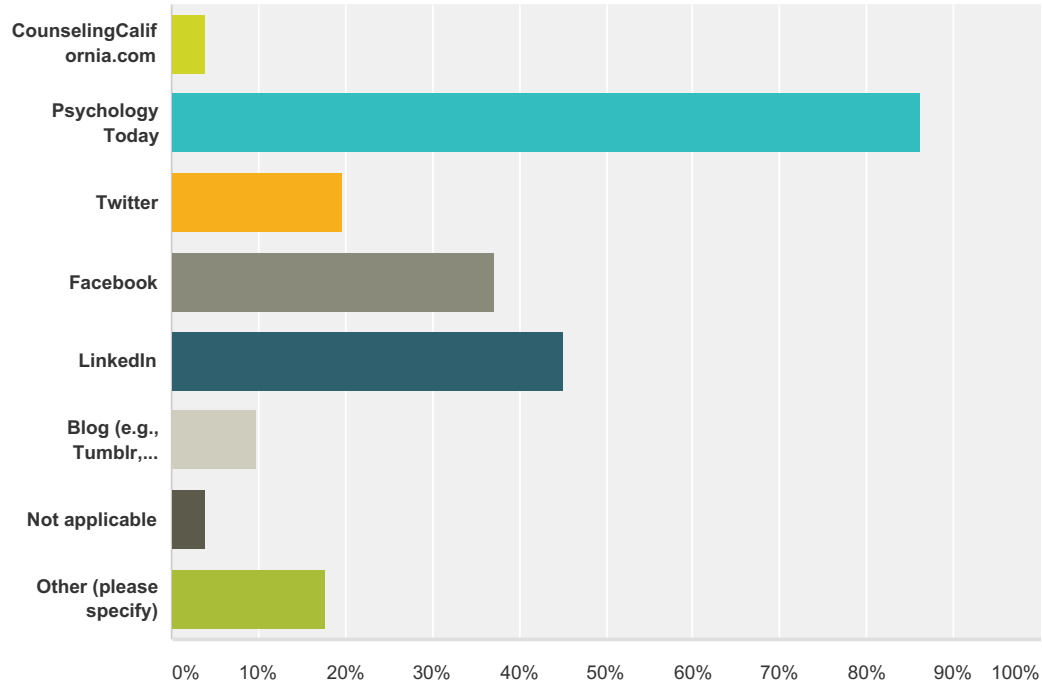

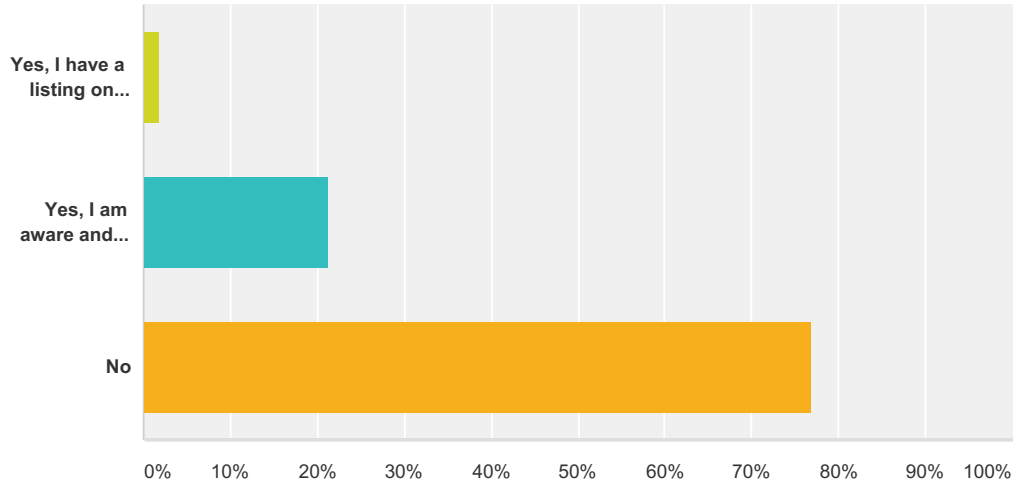

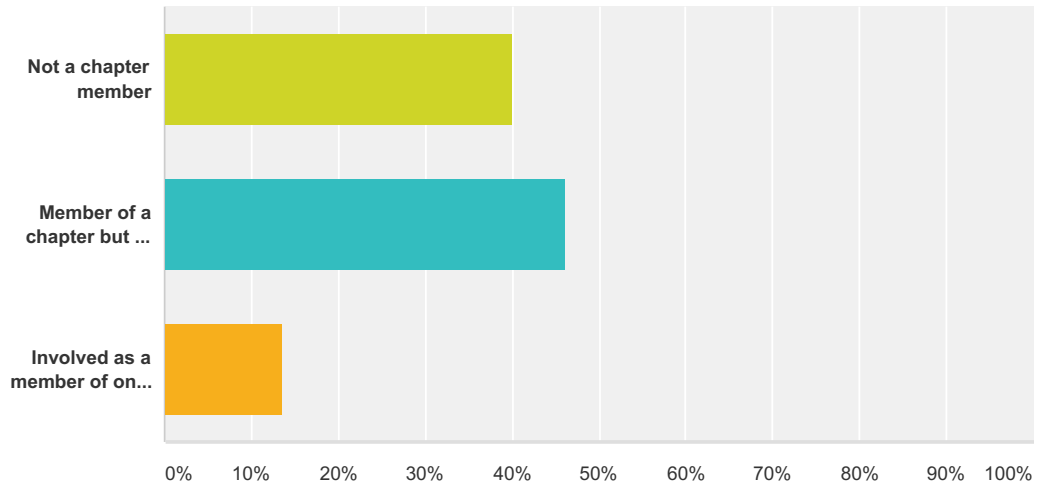

Q59 Are you involved in one or more CAMFT Chapters?

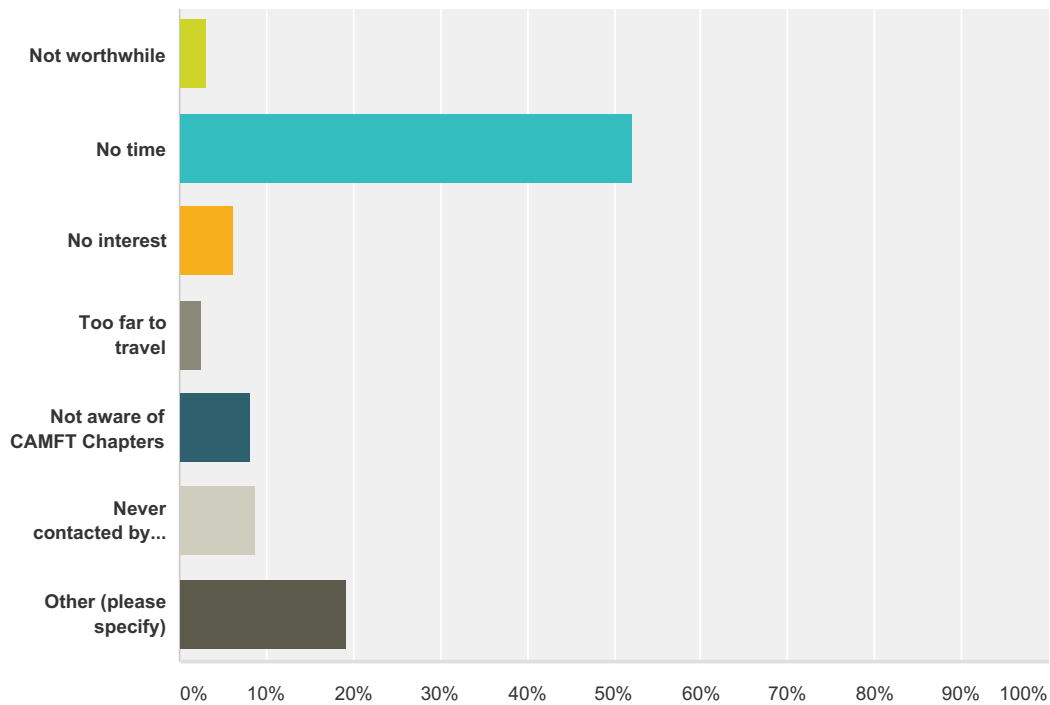
