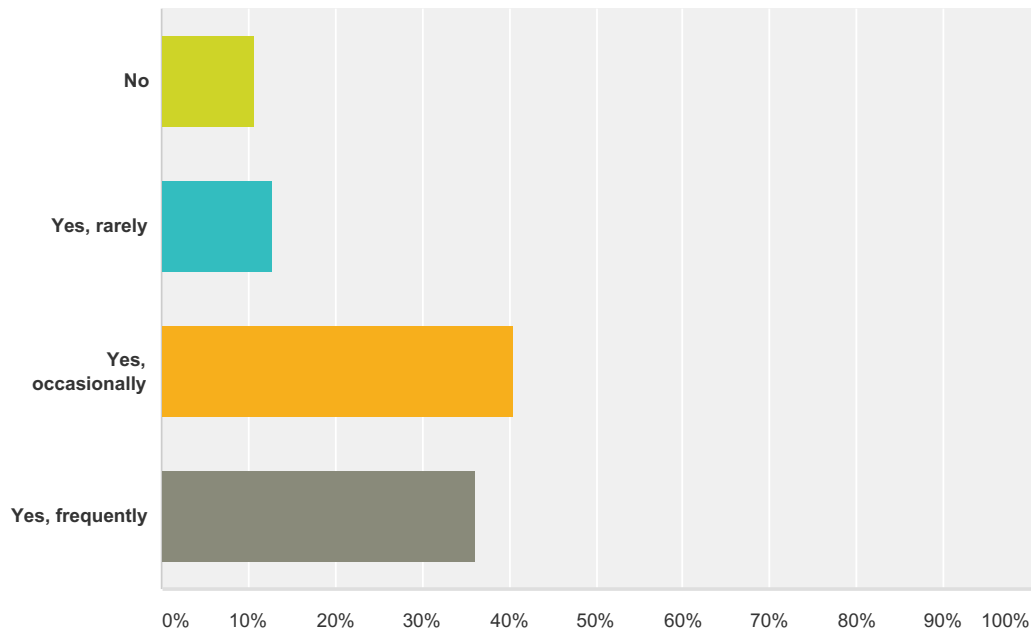

### Q9 Within the last two years, have you received personal psychotherapy?

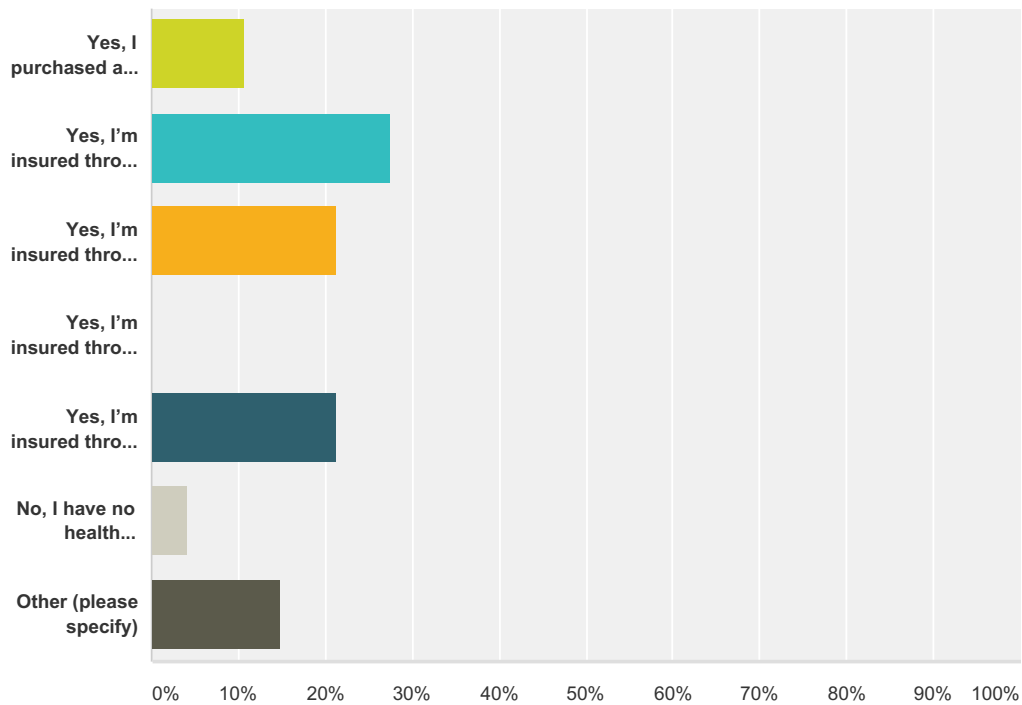

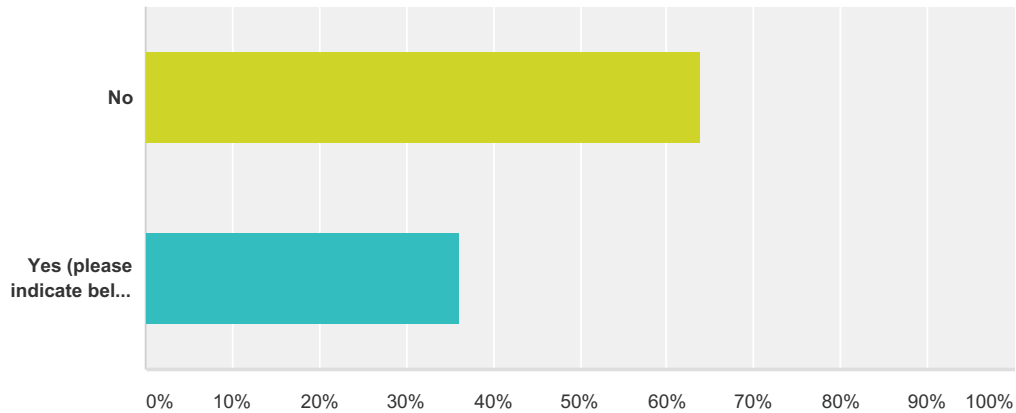

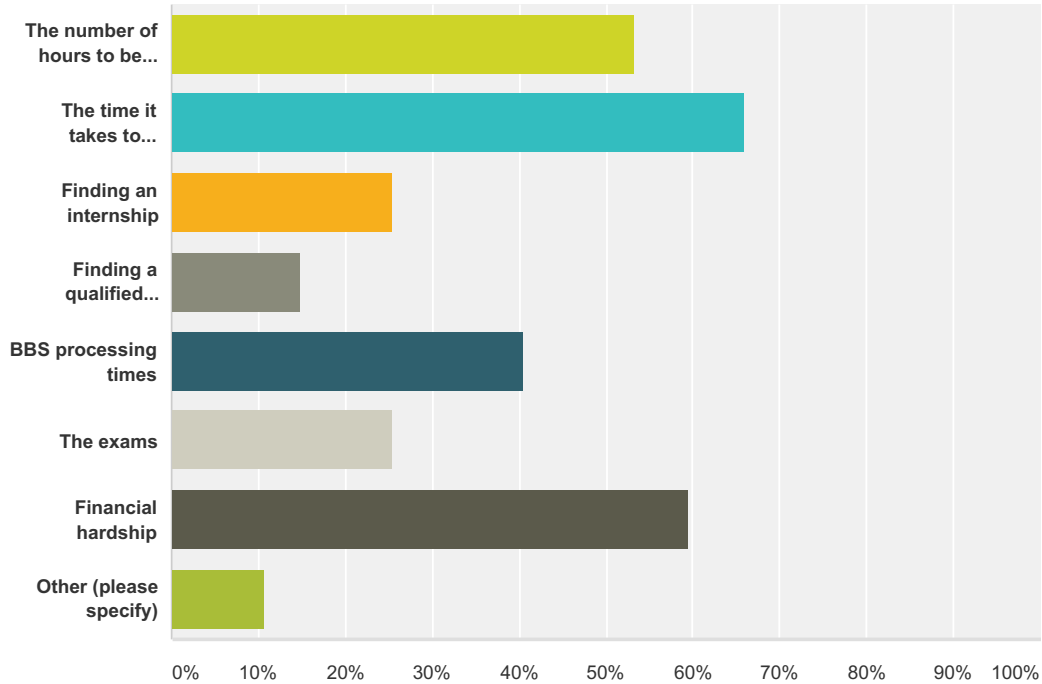

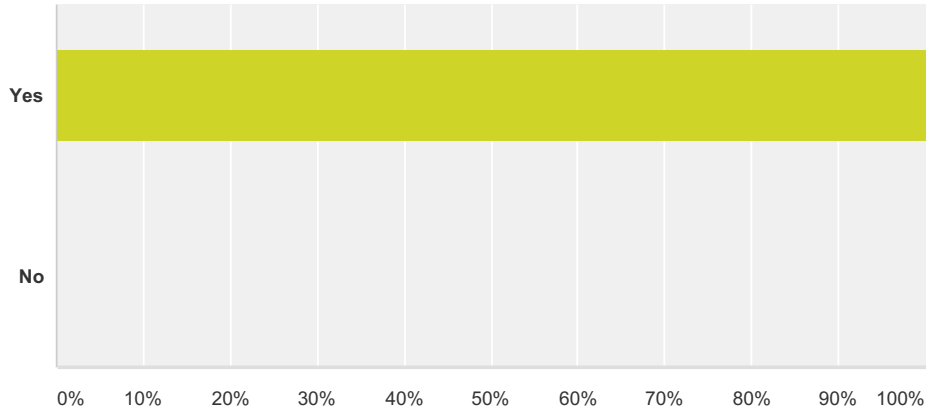

**Q15 Do you know about CAMFT’s free professional liability insurance for graduate student members?**

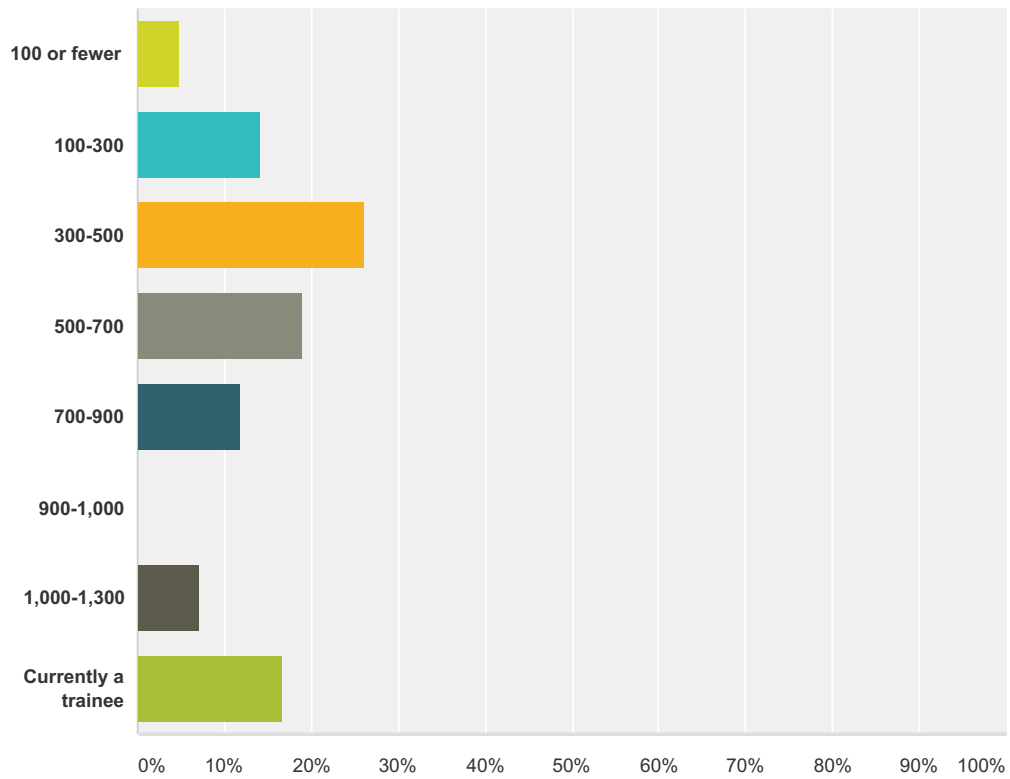

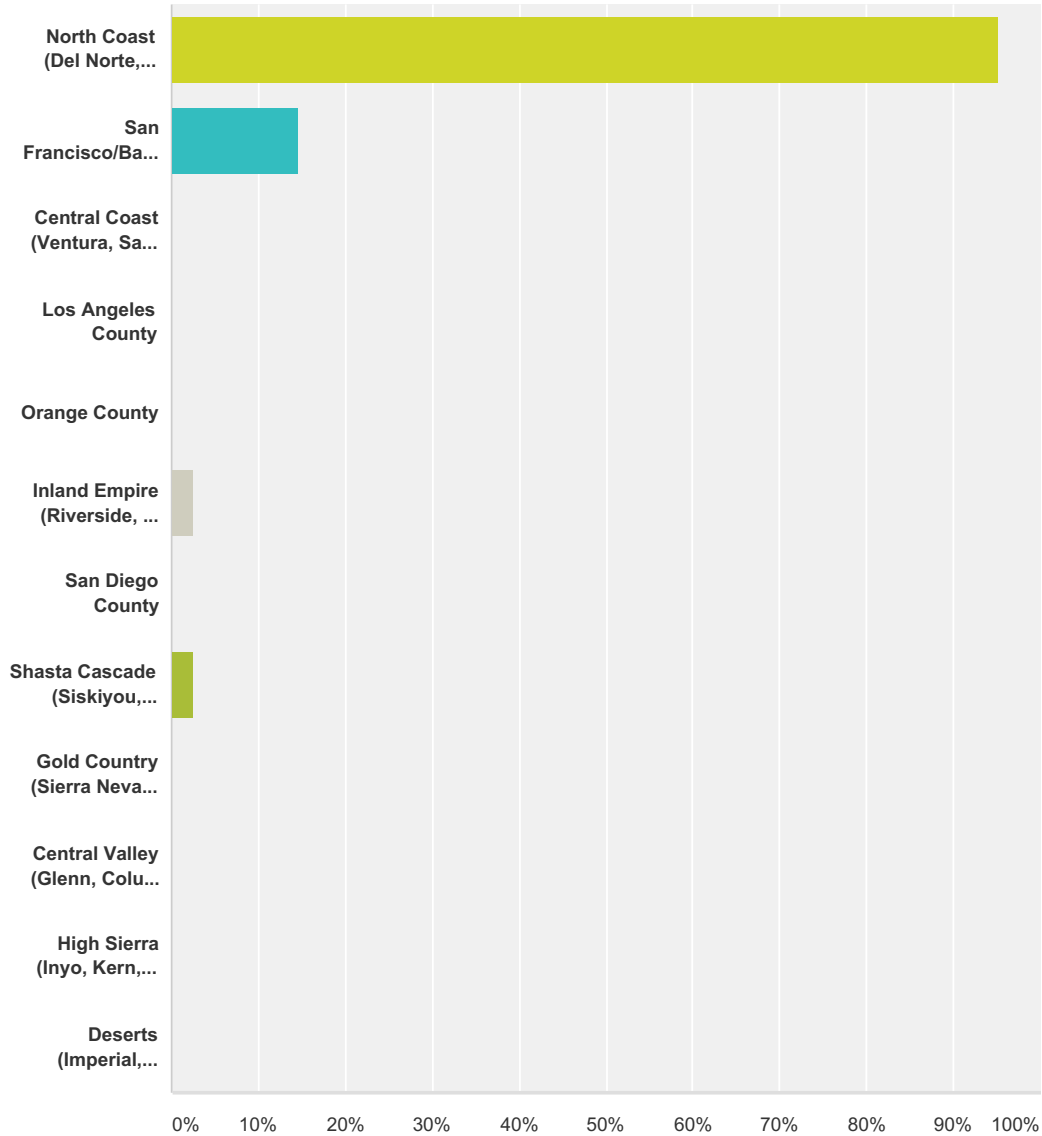

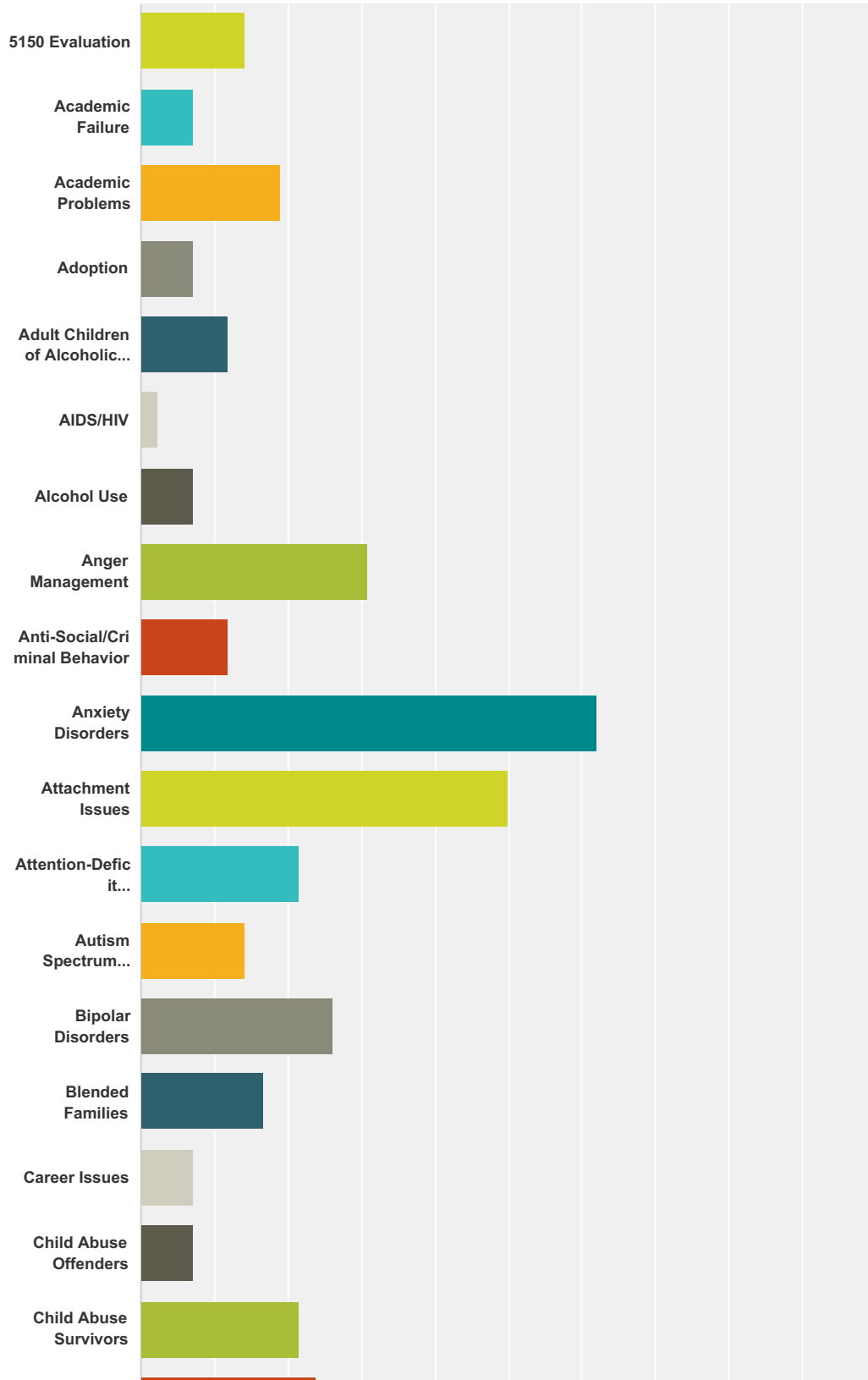

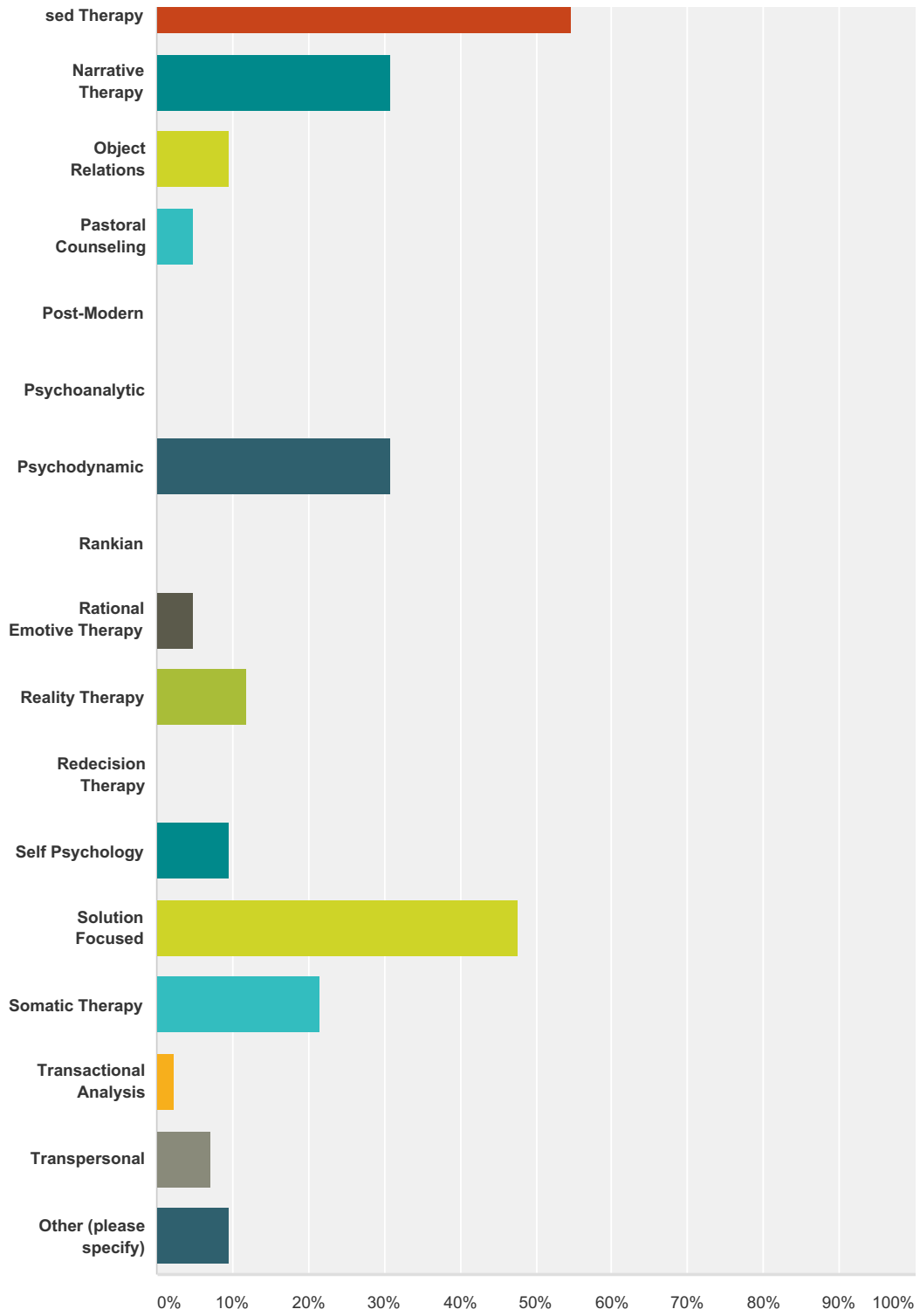
**Q22 Which of the following best describe your theoretical orientation? (Check all that apply)**

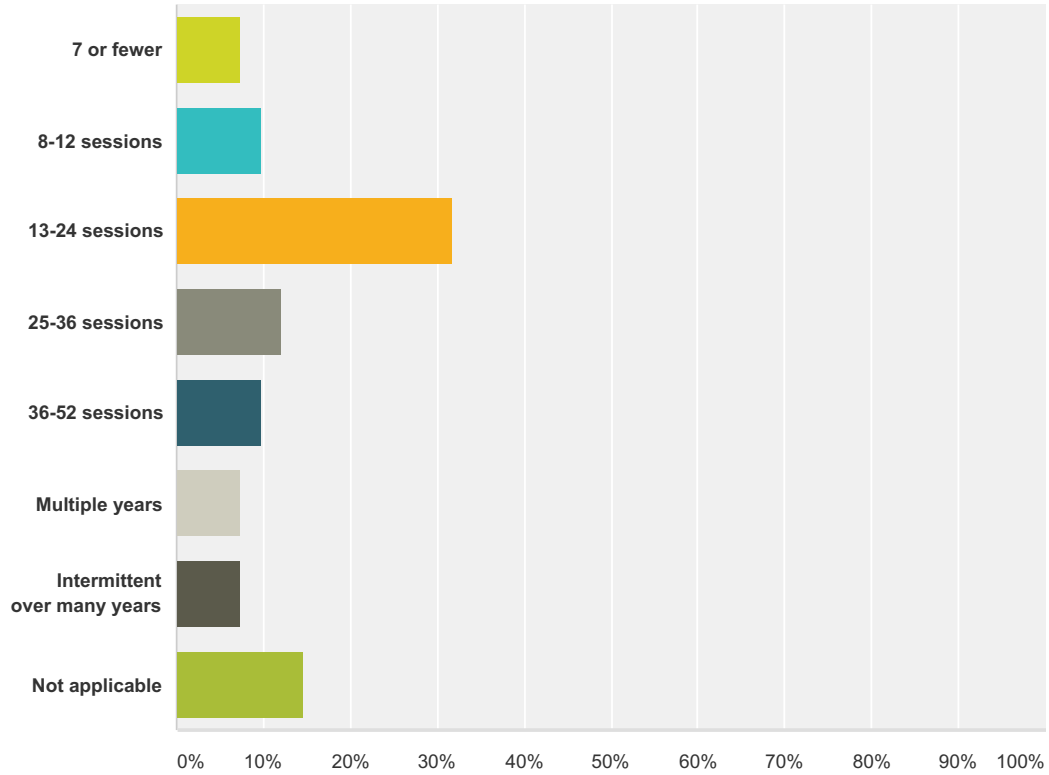

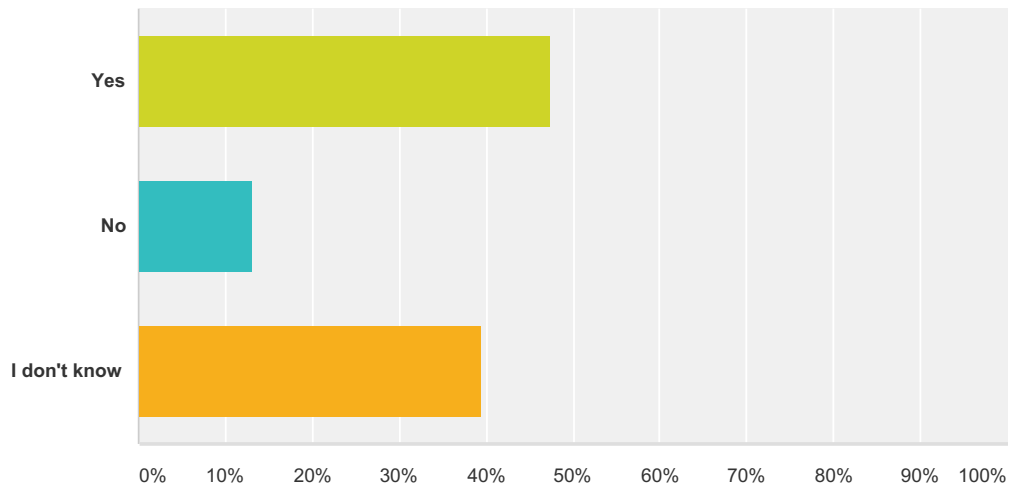

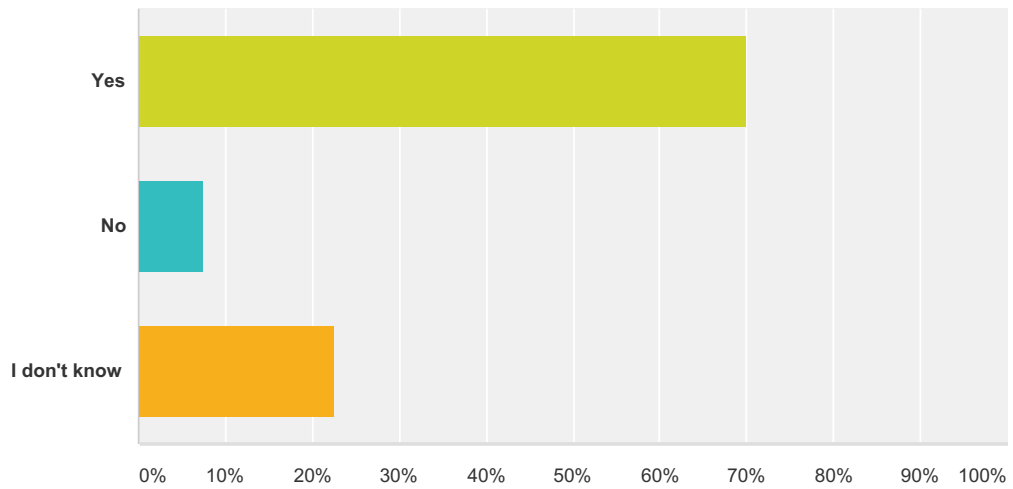

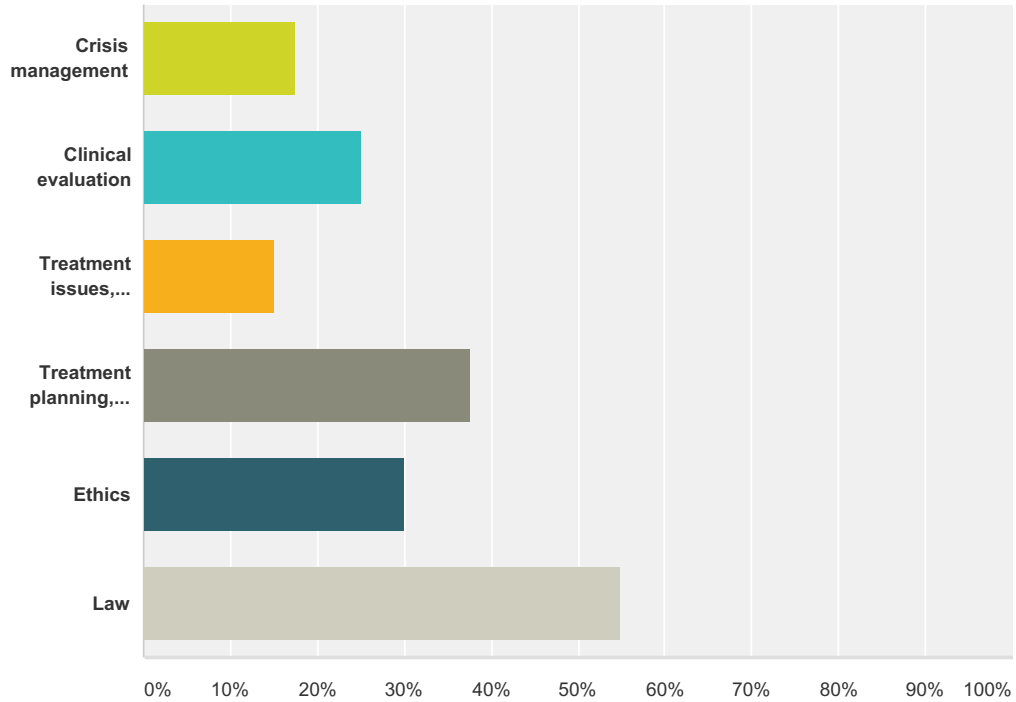

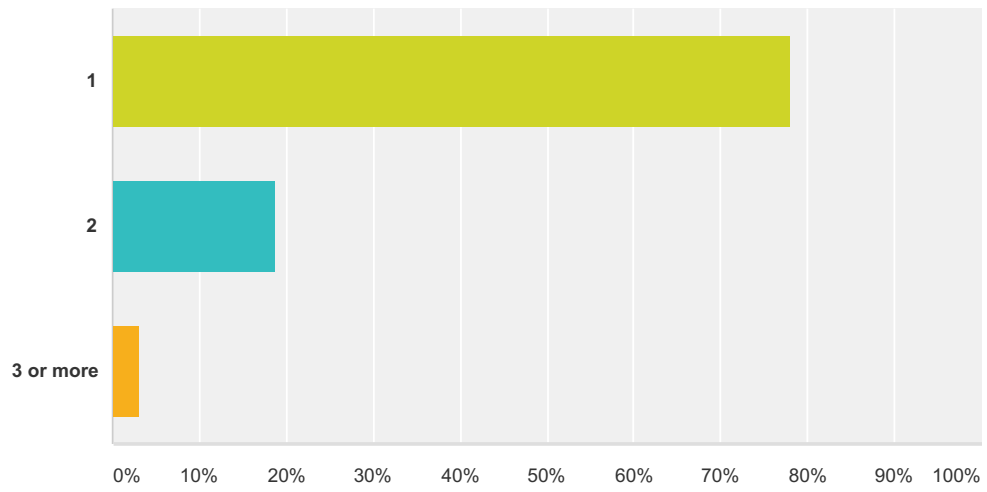

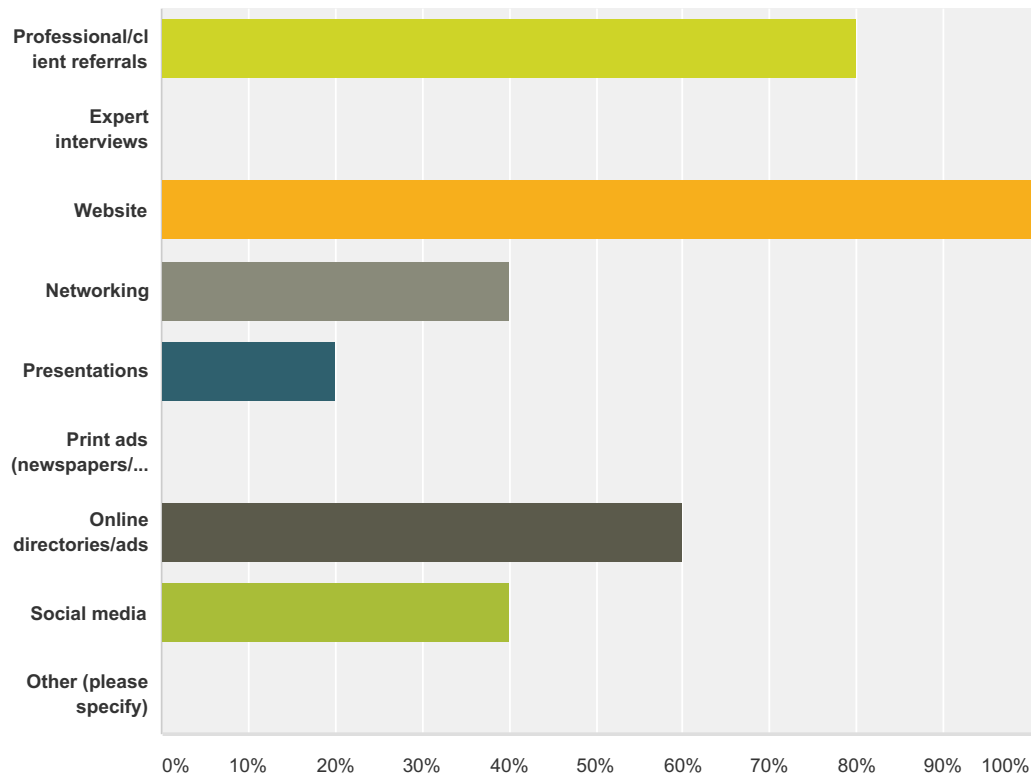

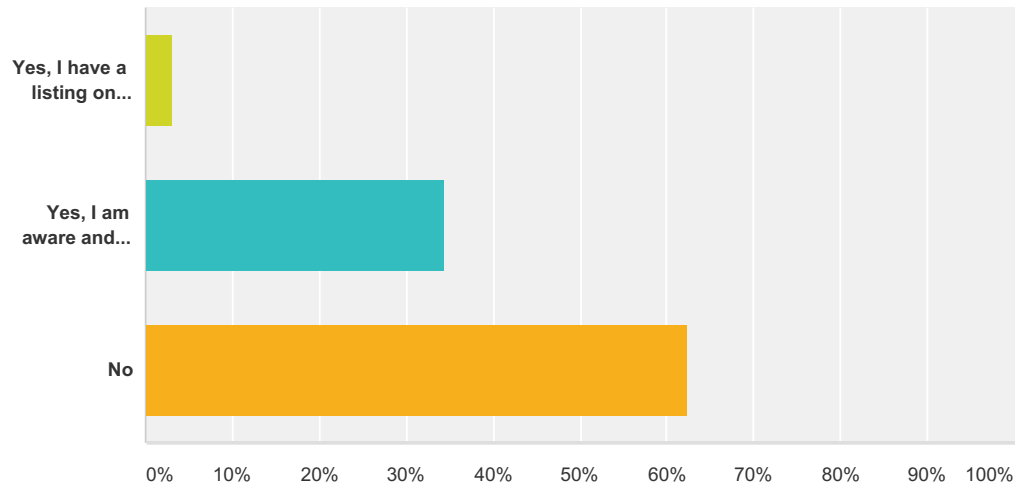

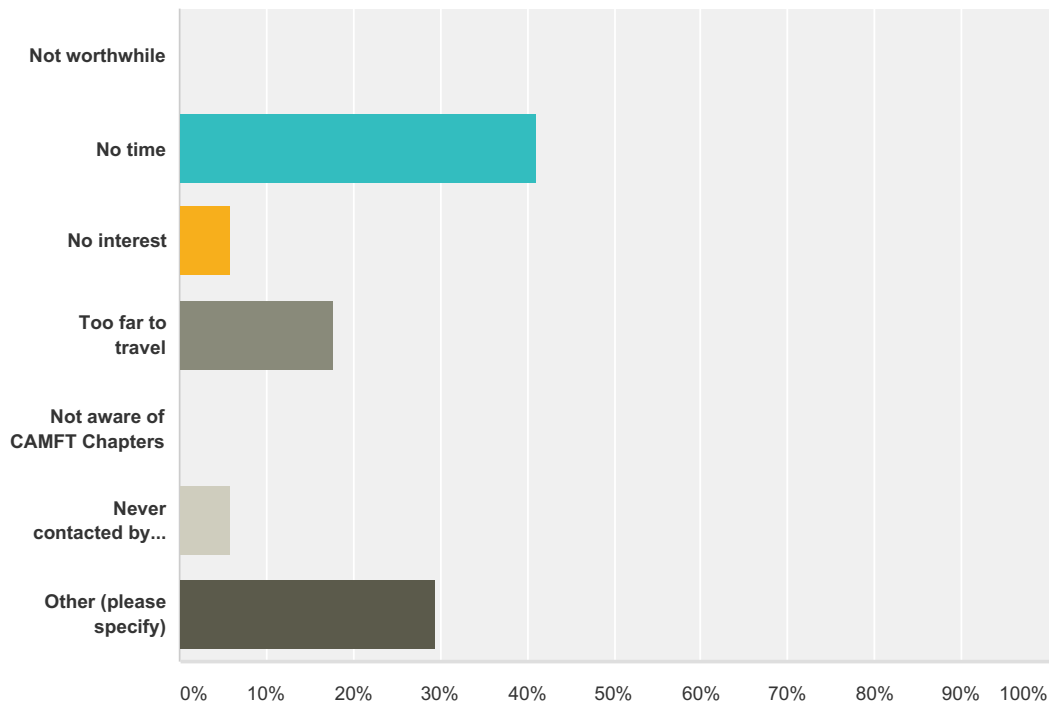
