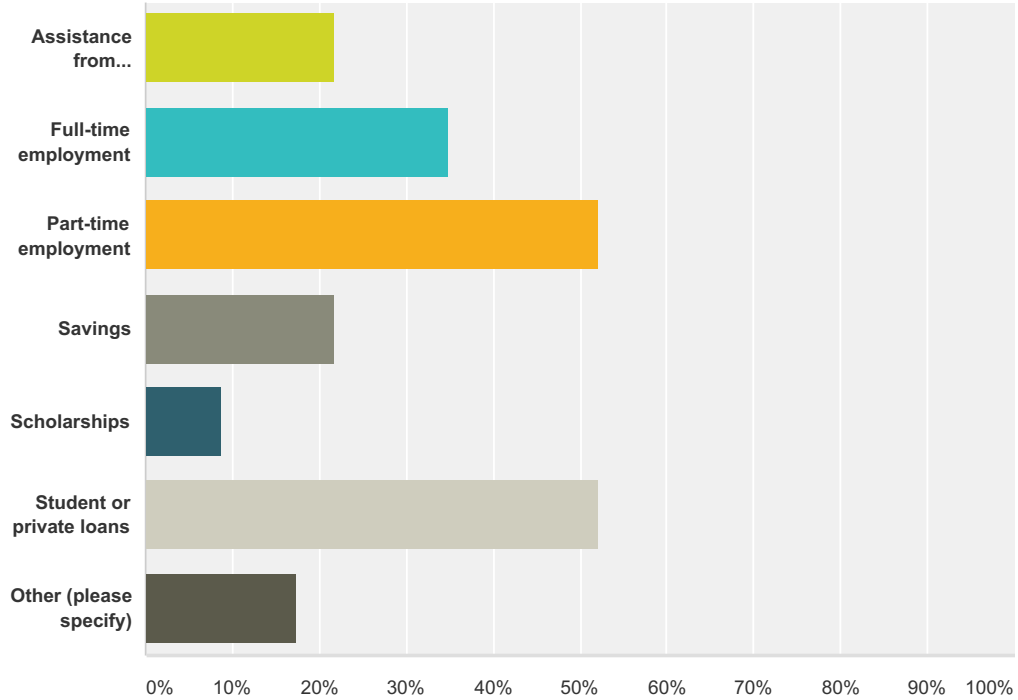

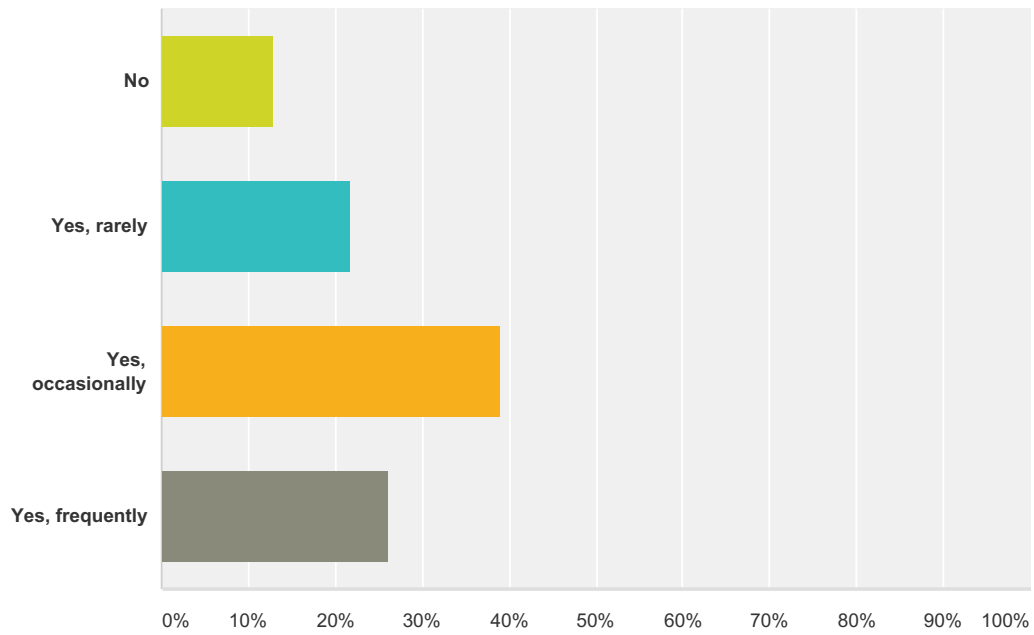

Q9 Within the last two years, have you received personal psychotherapy?

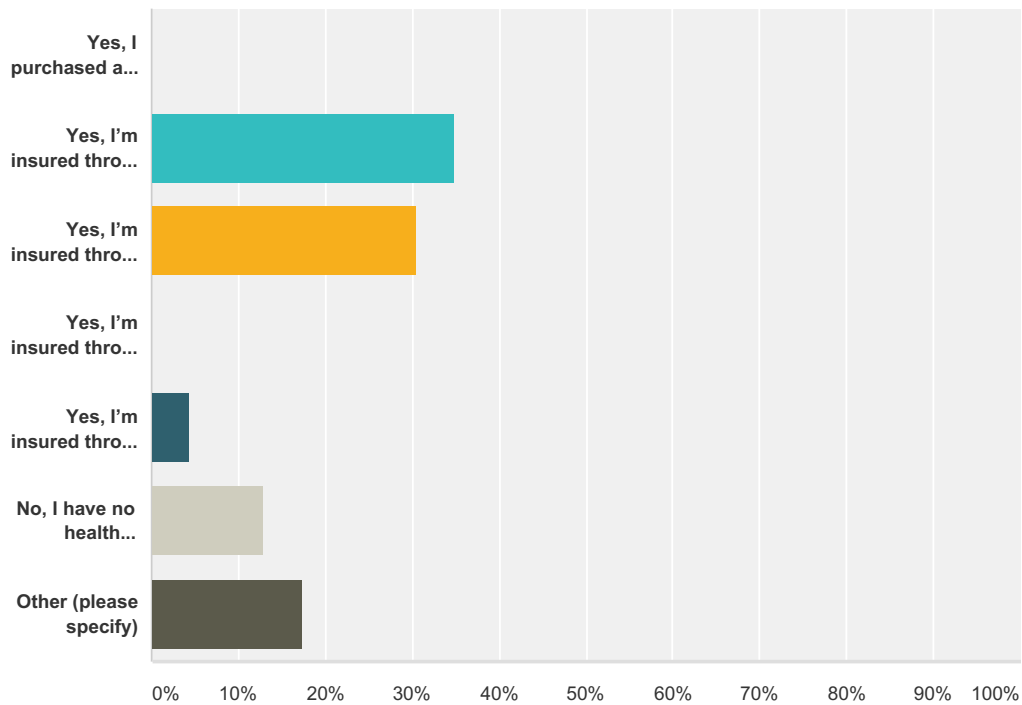

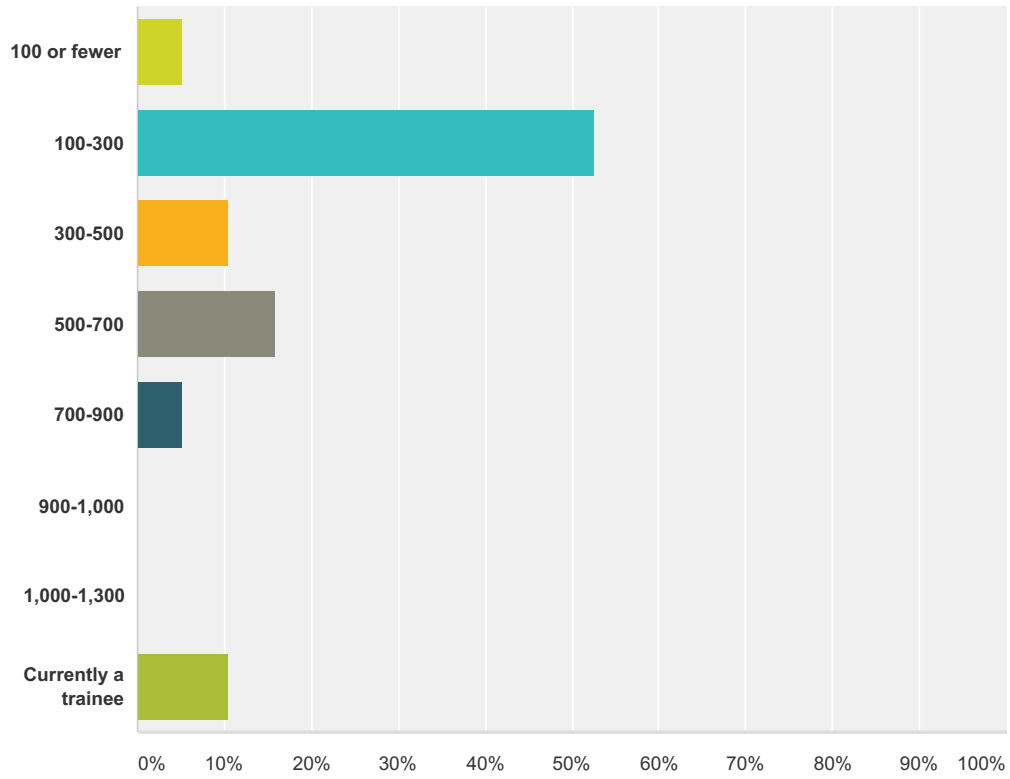

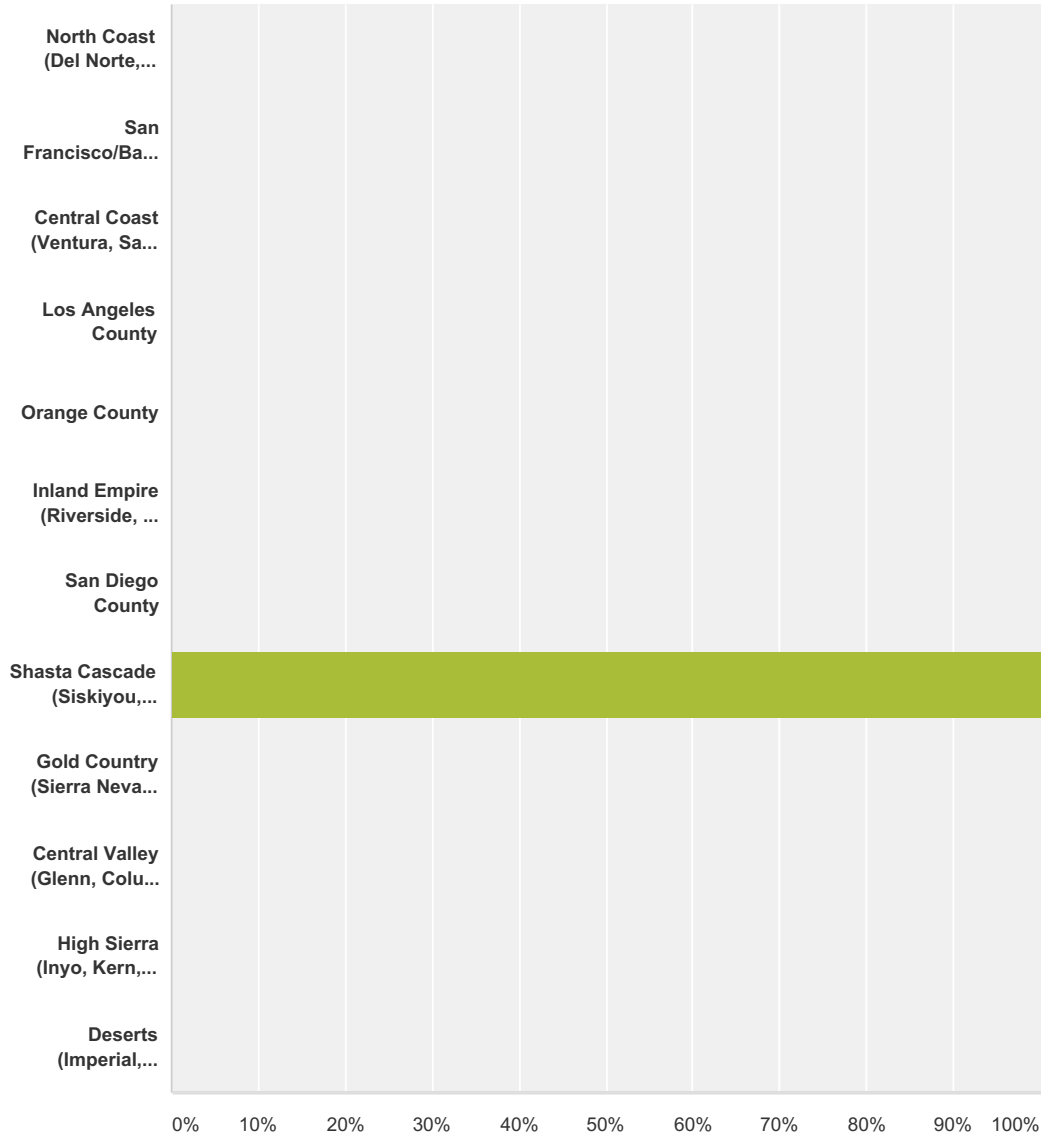

Q20 Do you believe you have sufficient educational training to treat culturally diverse patients?

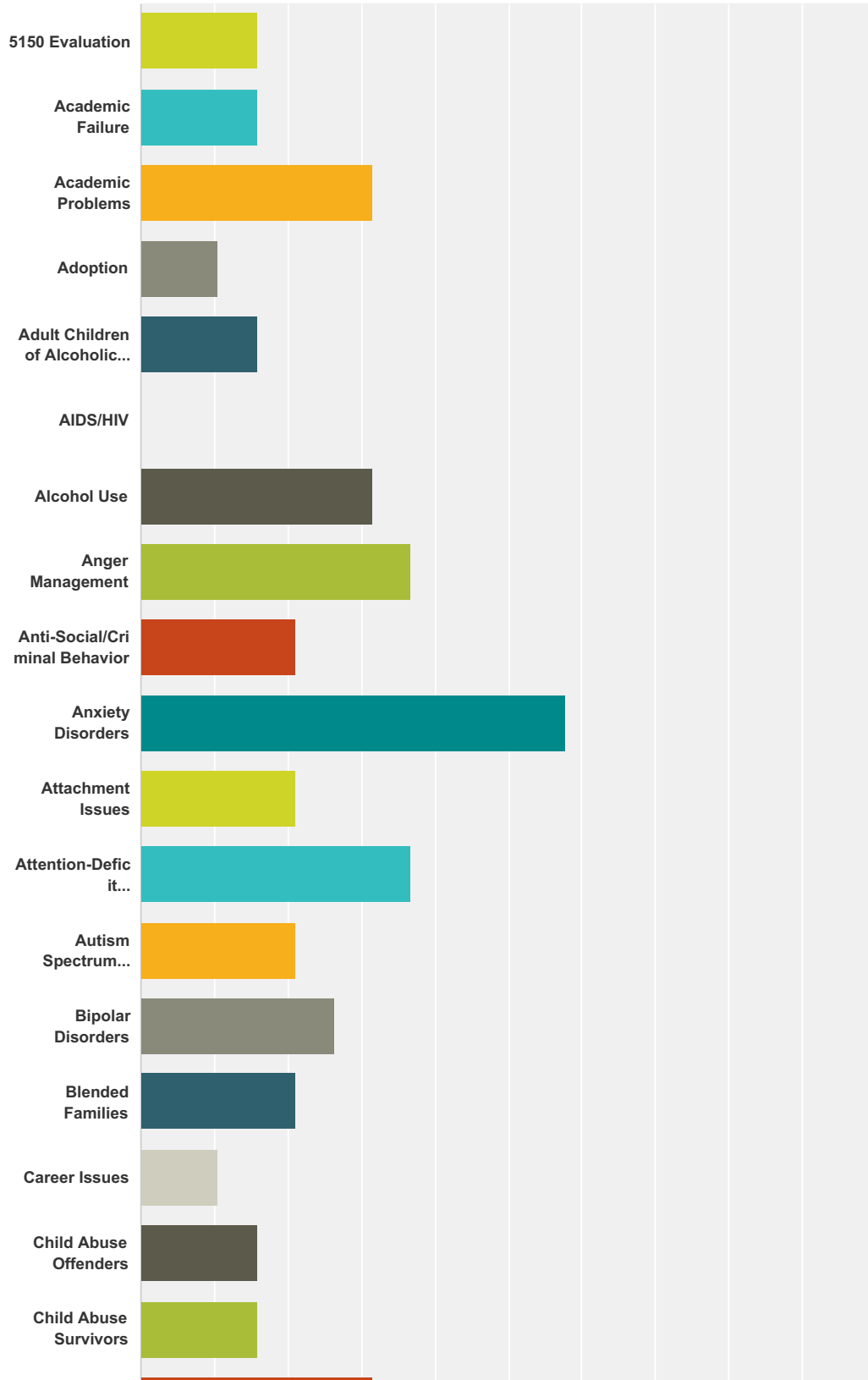

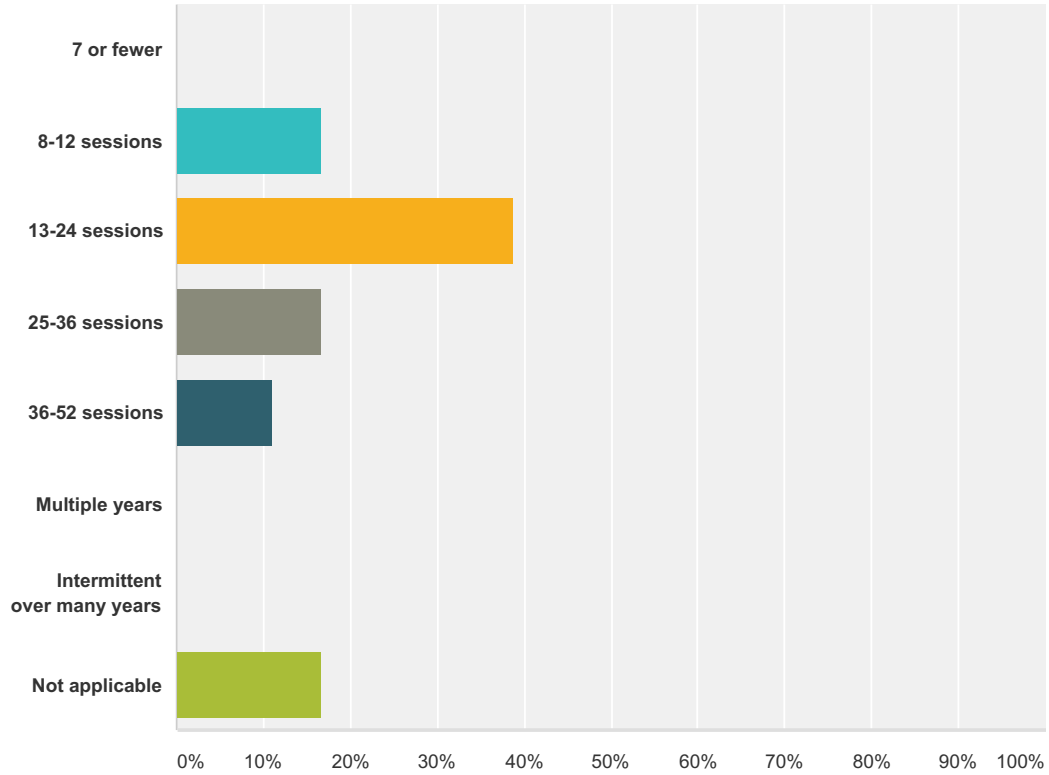

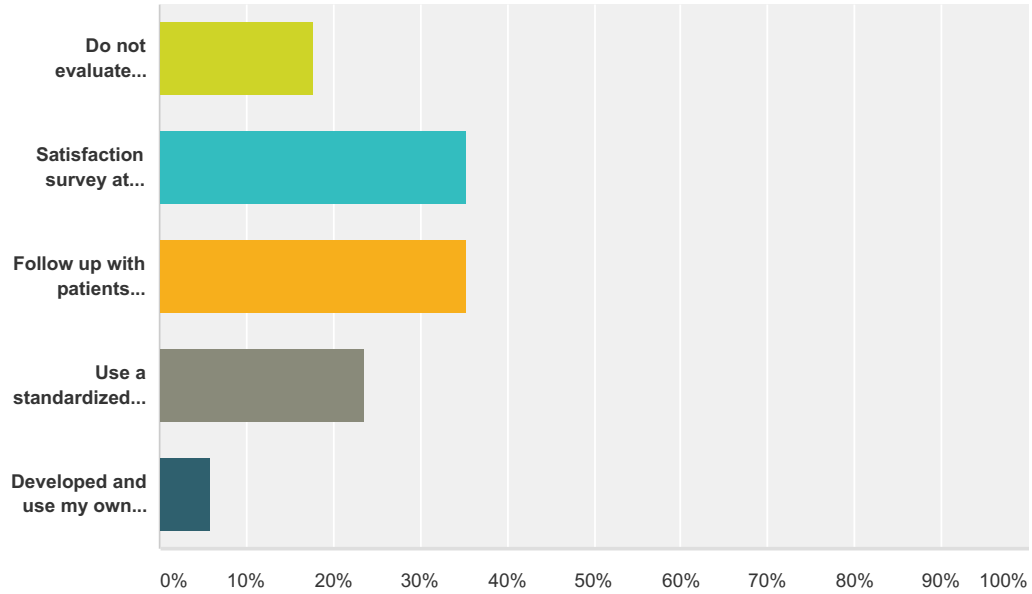

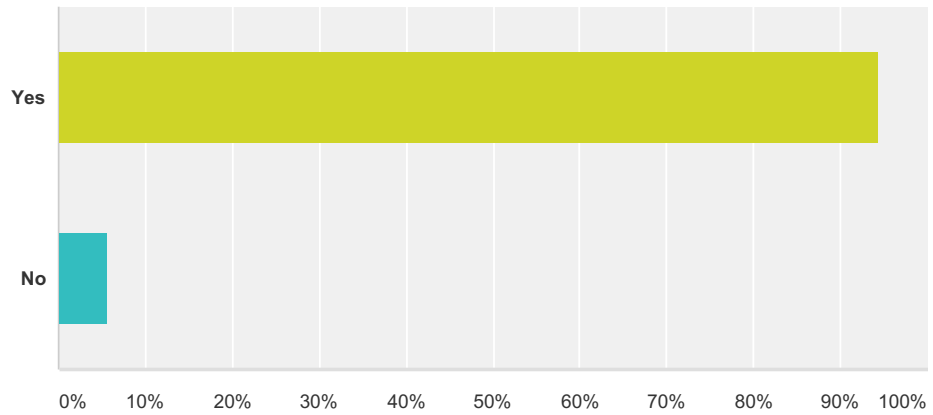

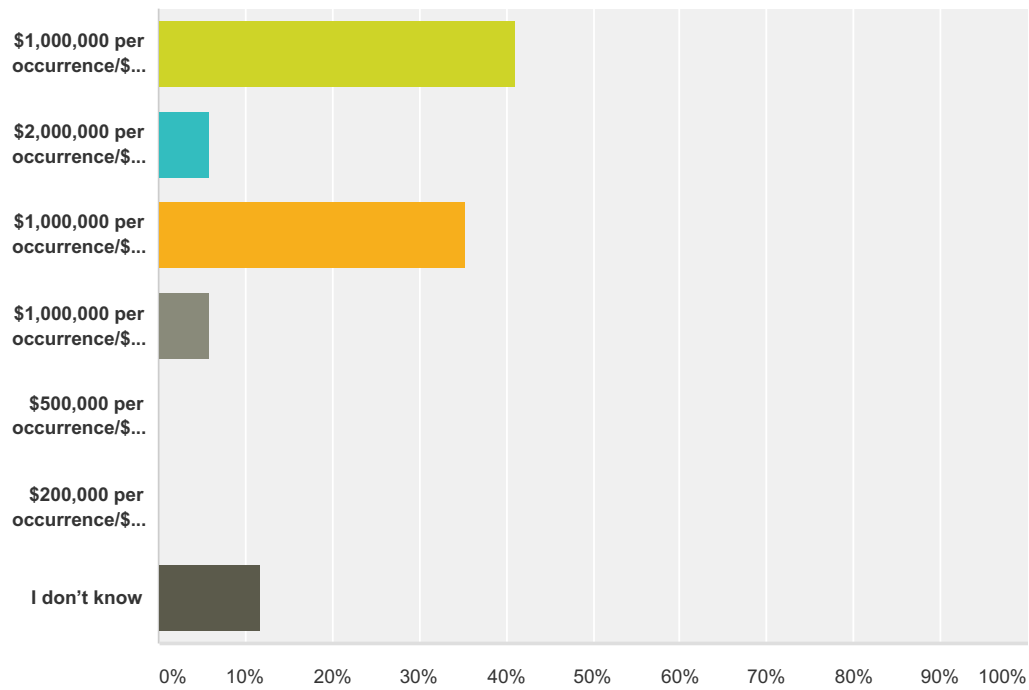

Q28 What are the limits of your malpractice coverage?

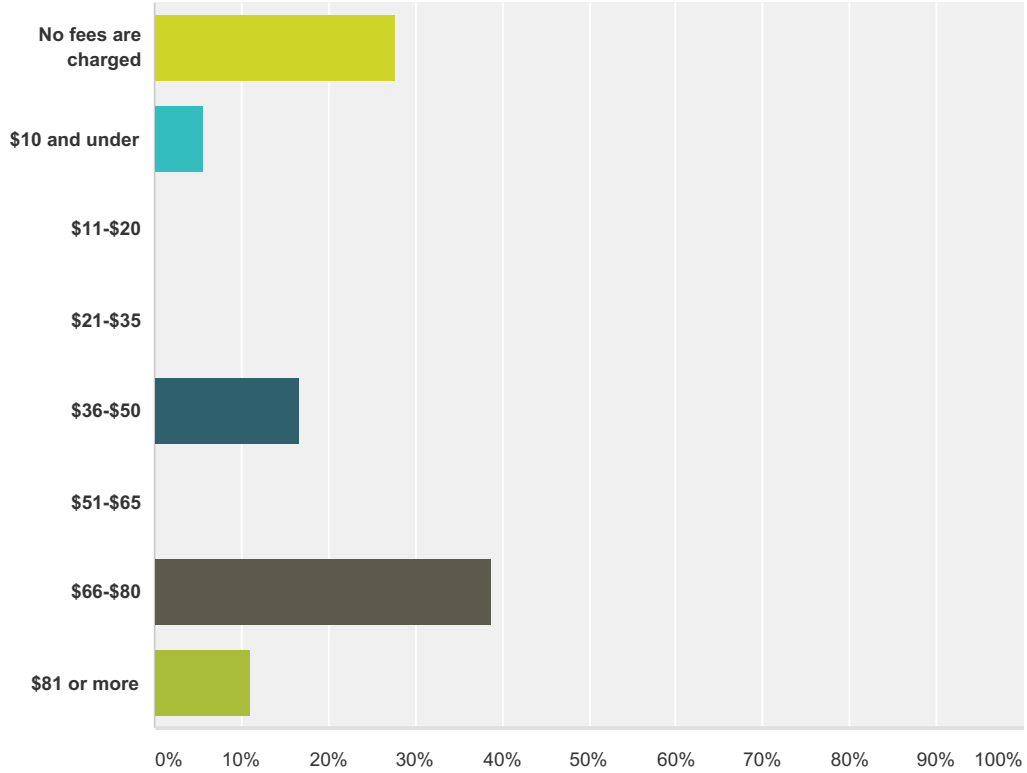

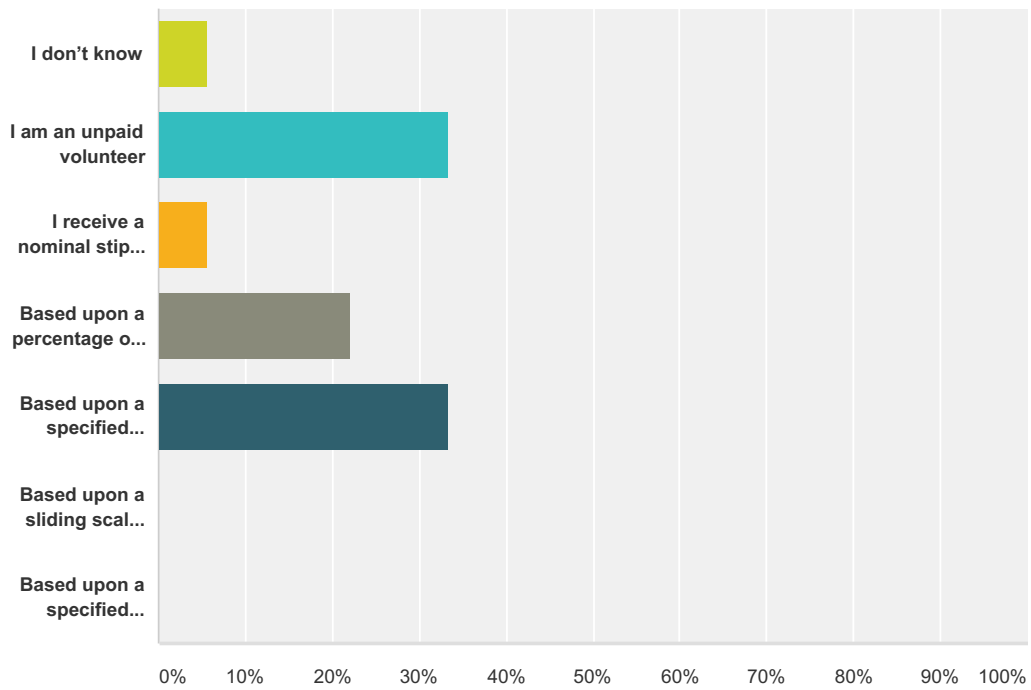

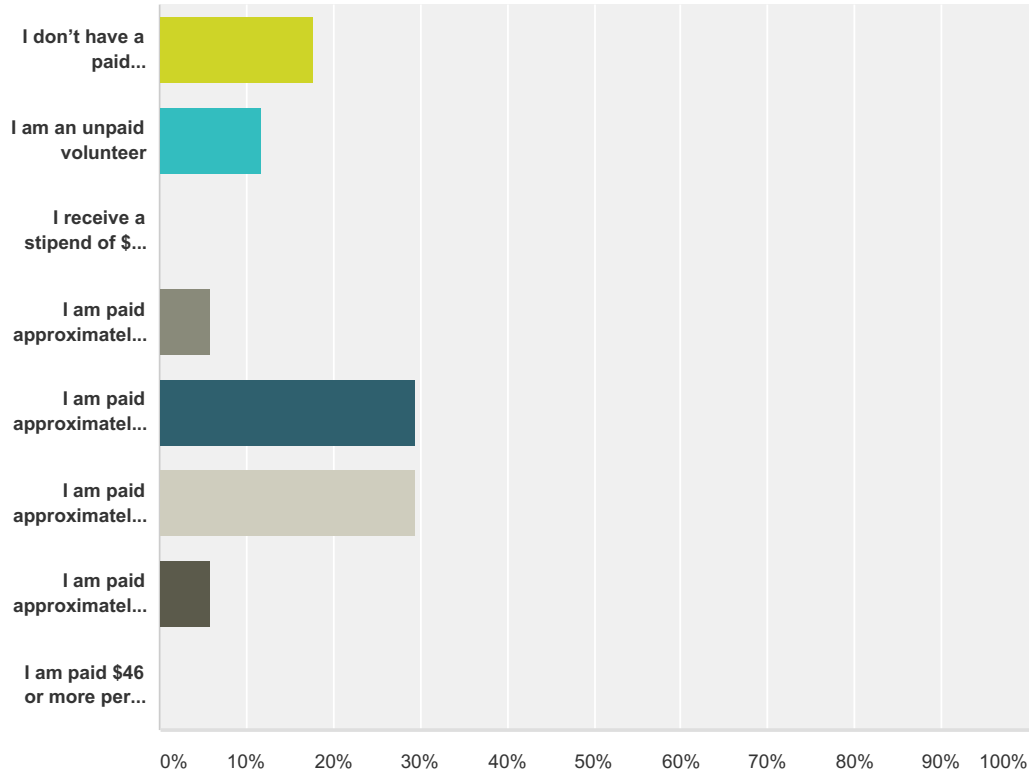

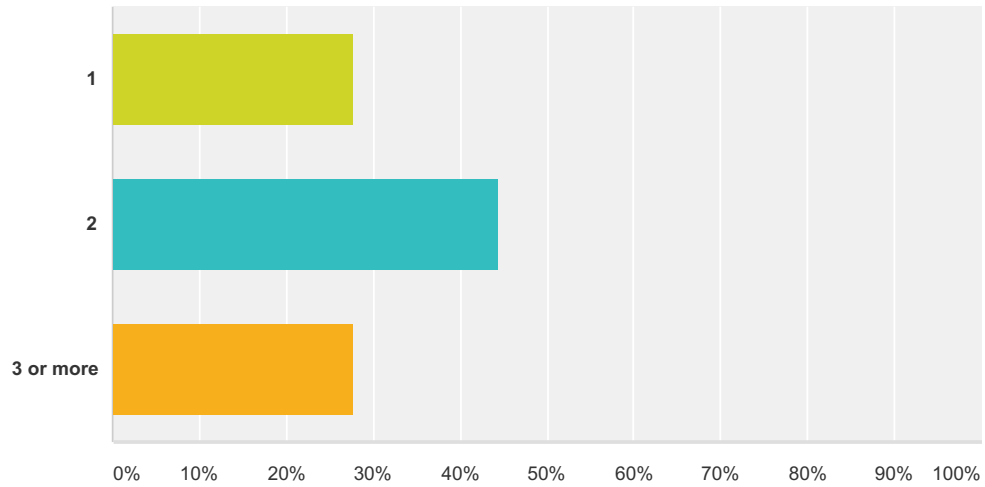

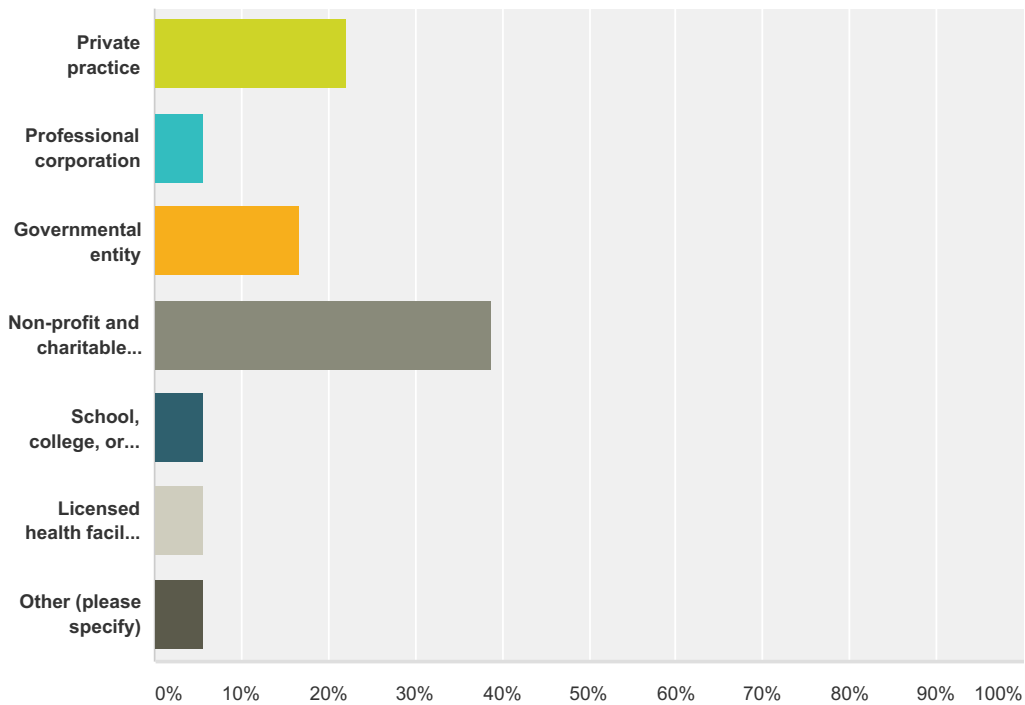

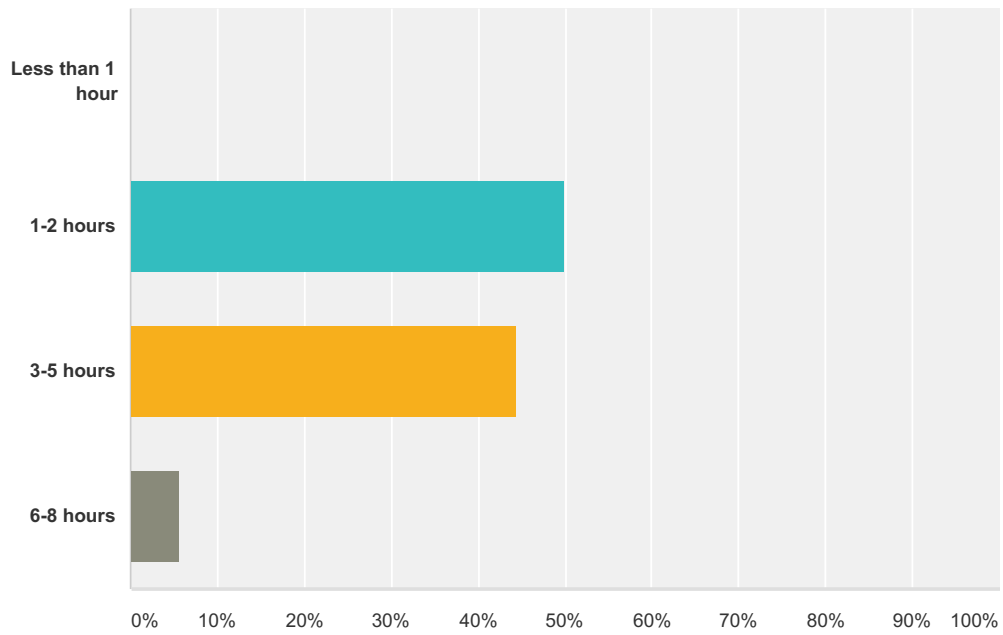

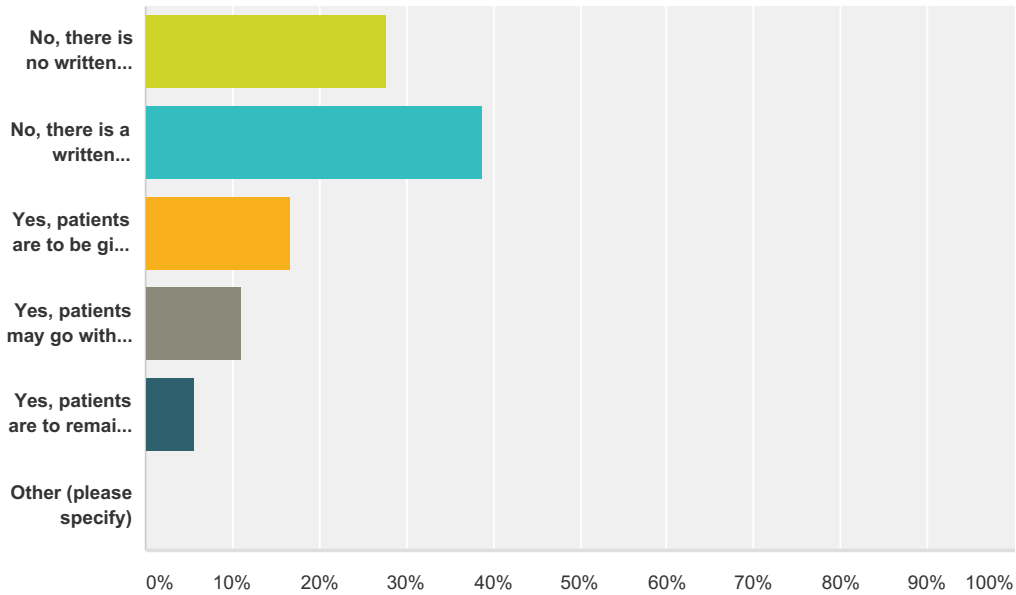

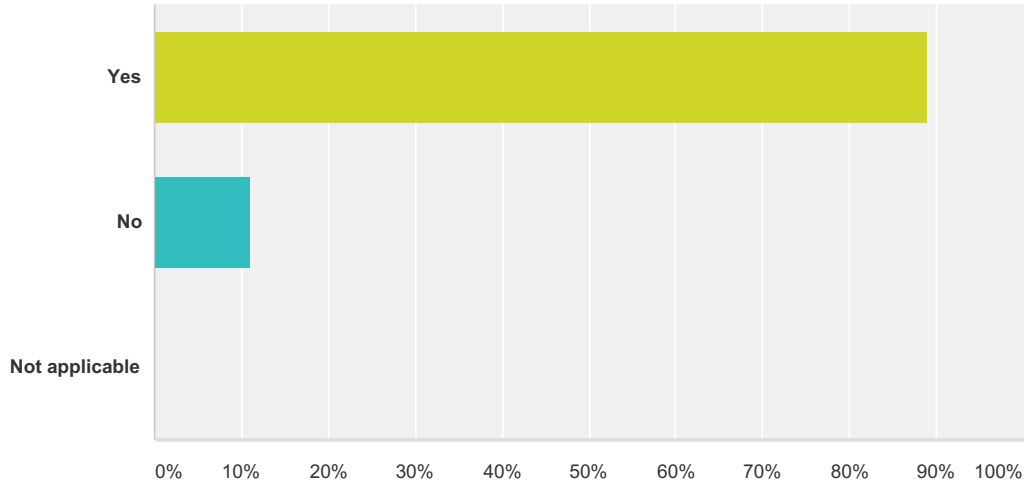

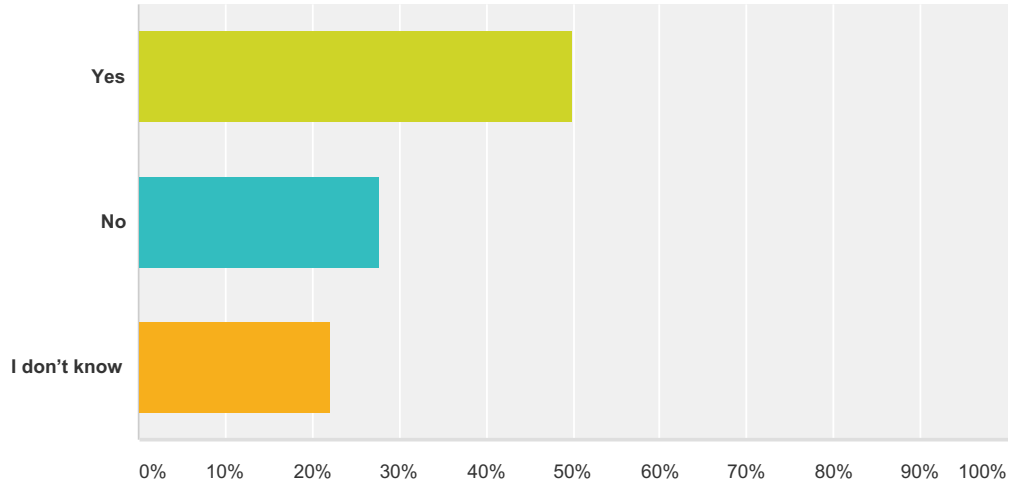

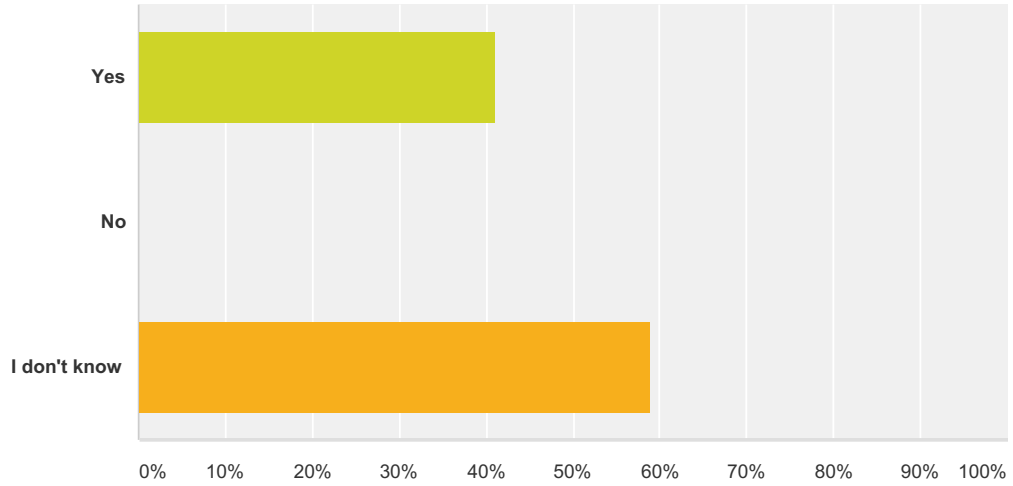

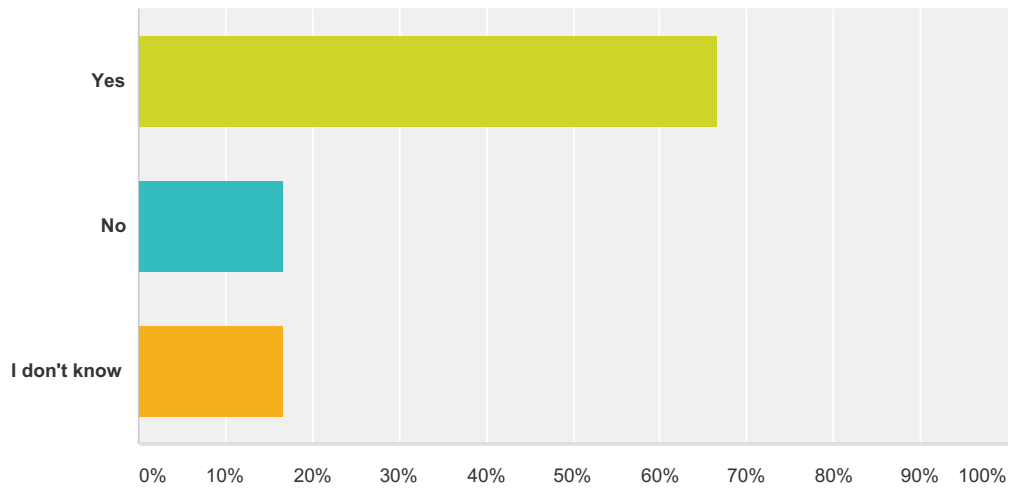

Q41 Once you are licensed, do you plan to work with Medi-Cal clients?

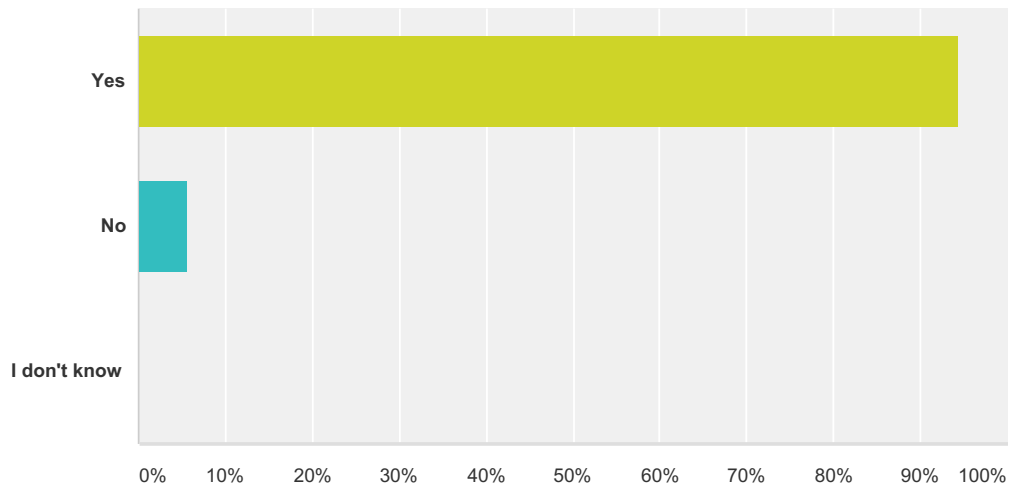

Q42 If MFTs could accept Medicare clients, would you work with Medicare clients?

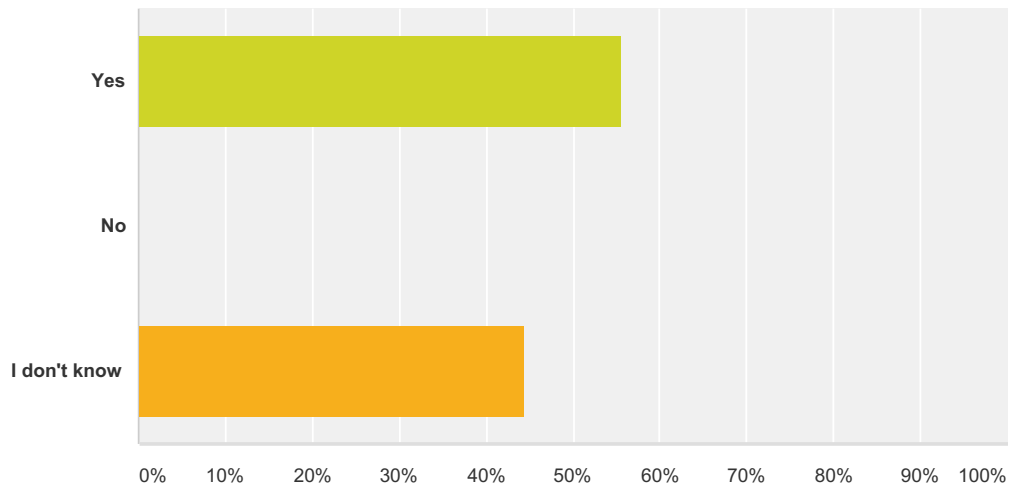

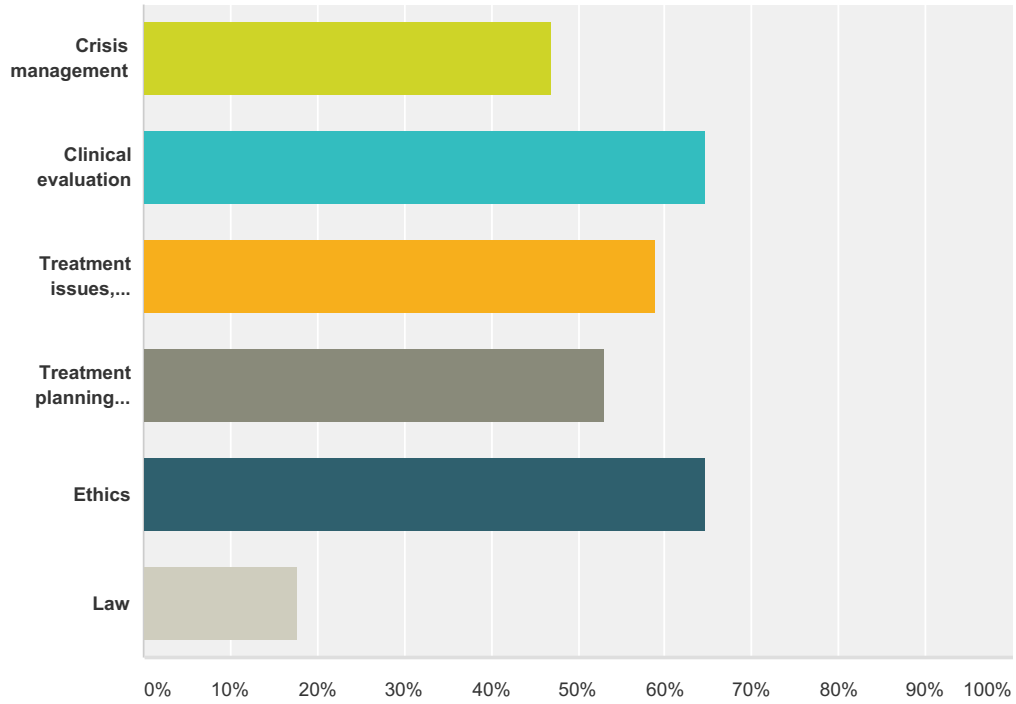

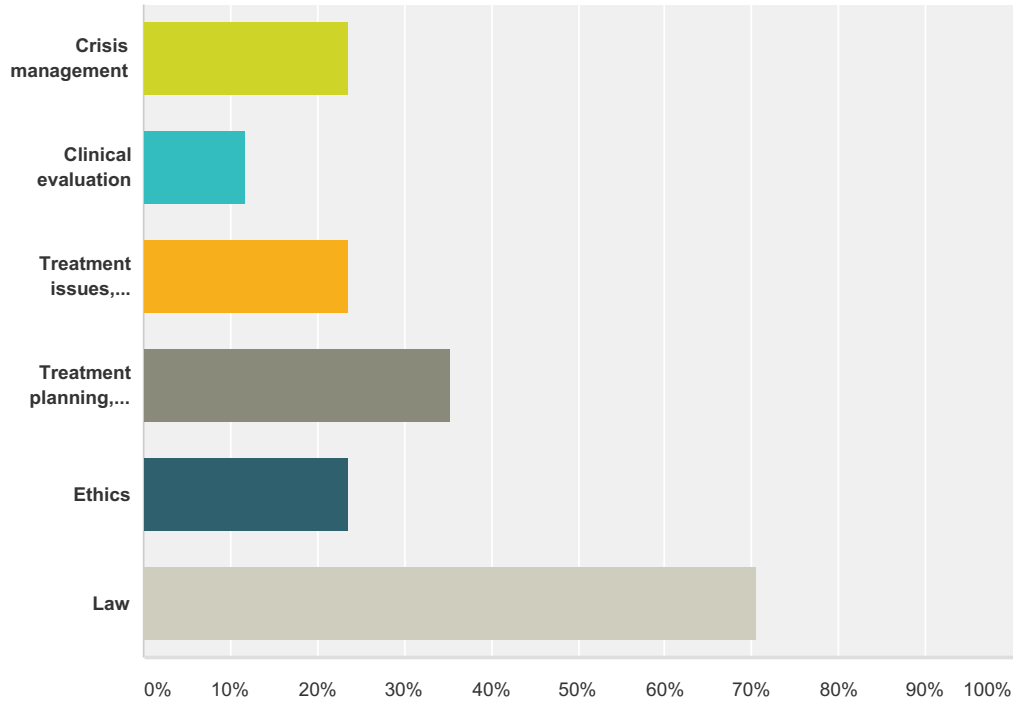

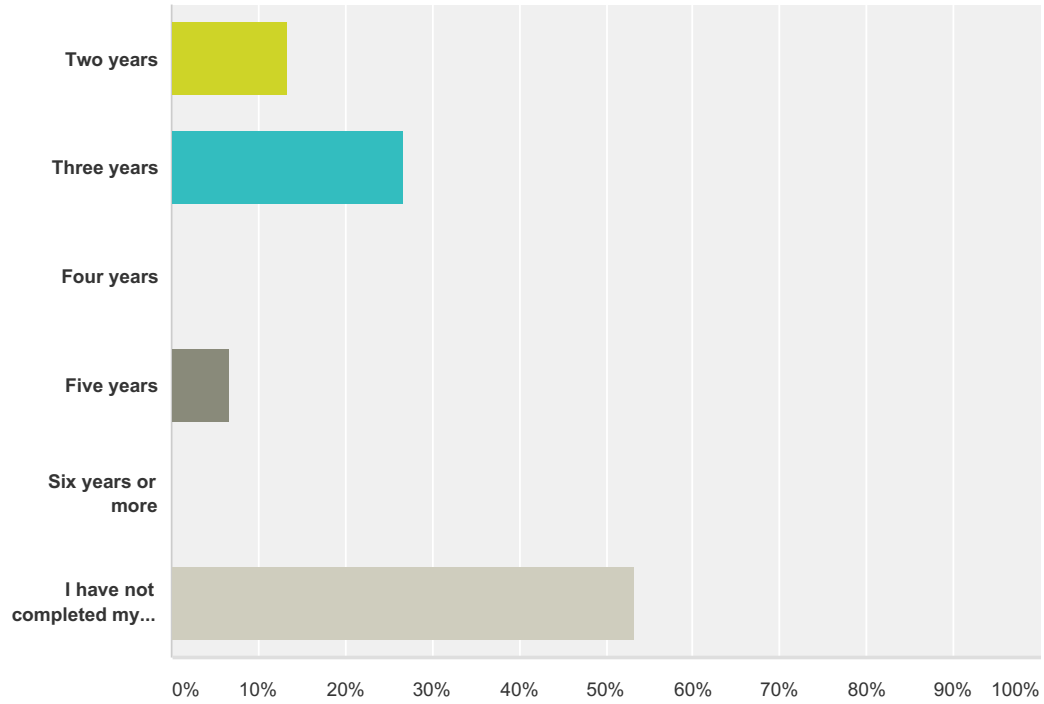

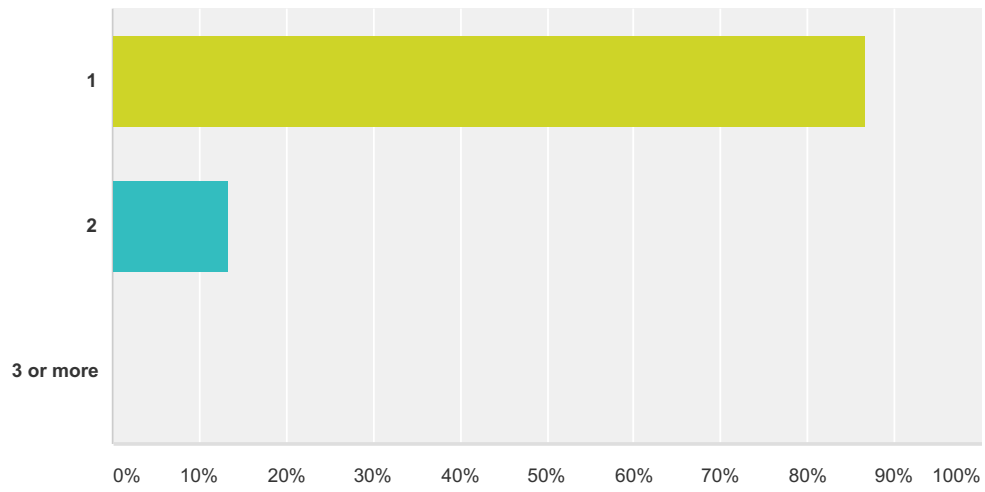

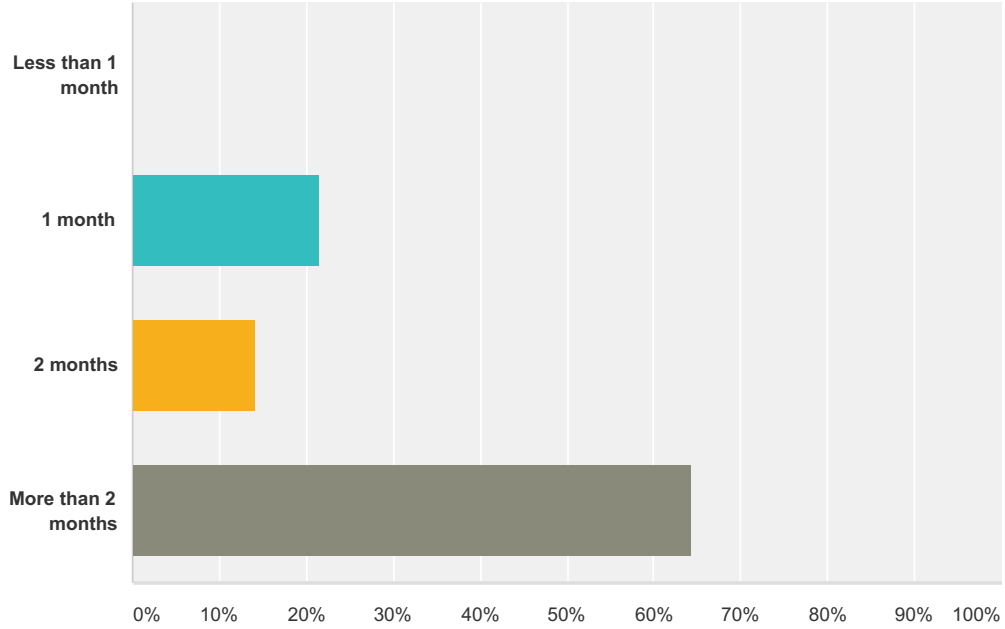

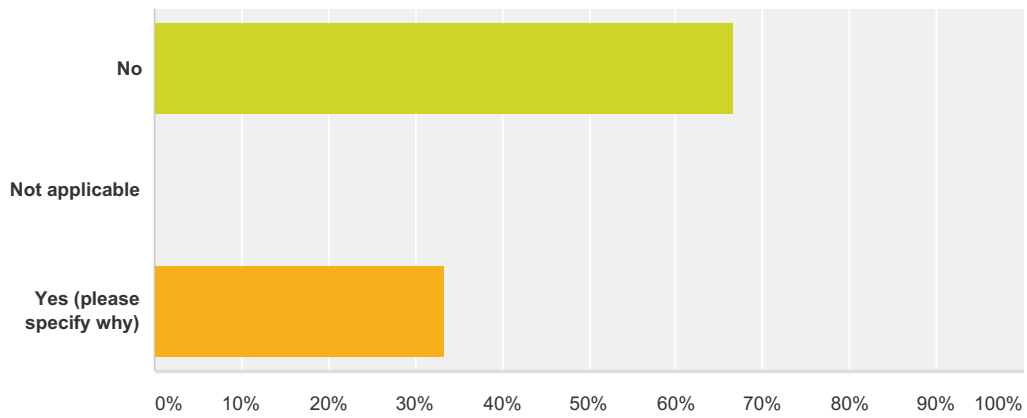

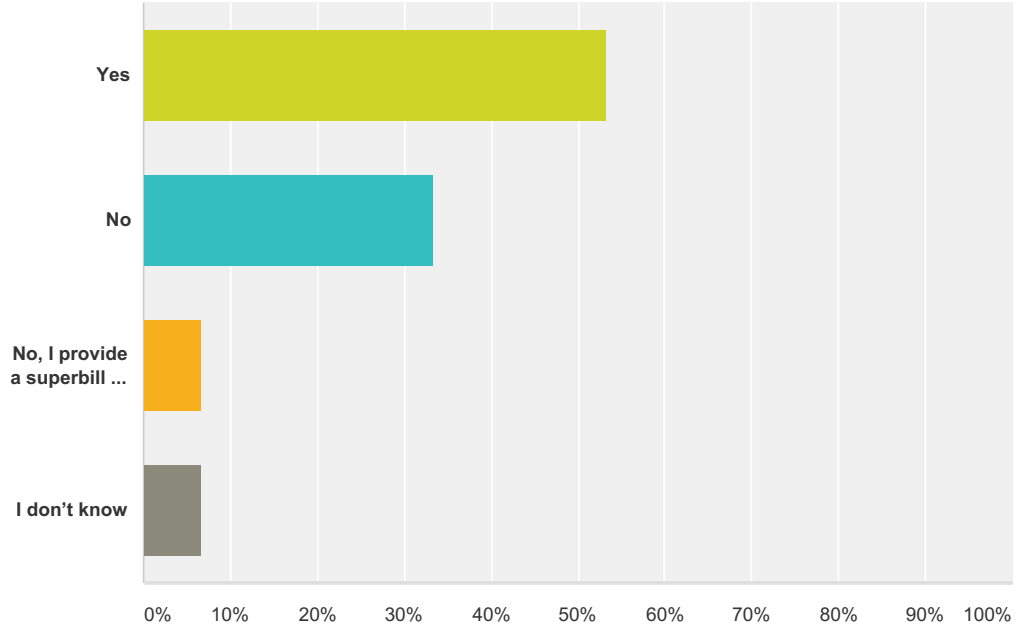

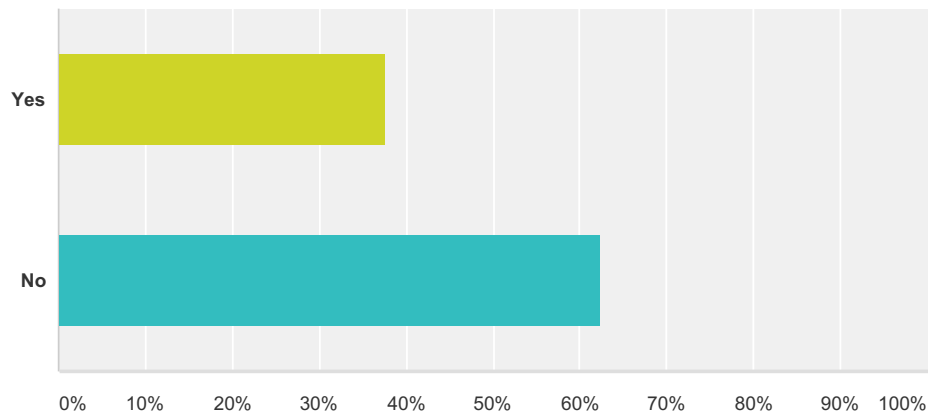

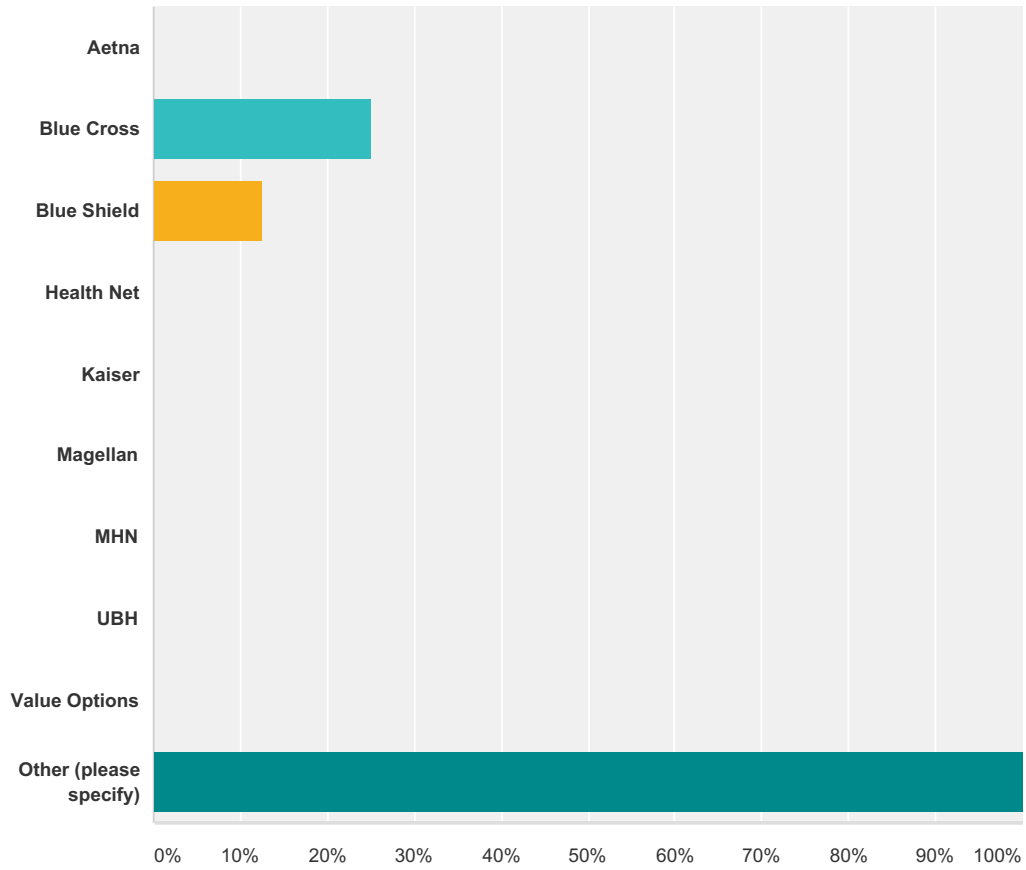

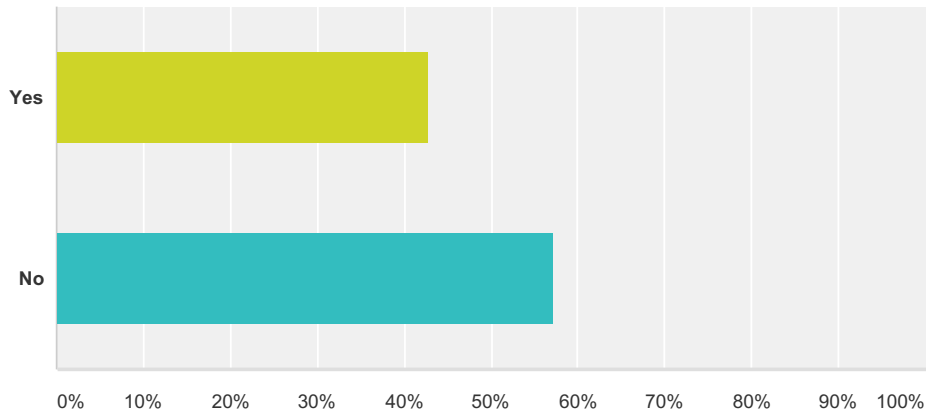

Q54 Do you advertise your professional services?

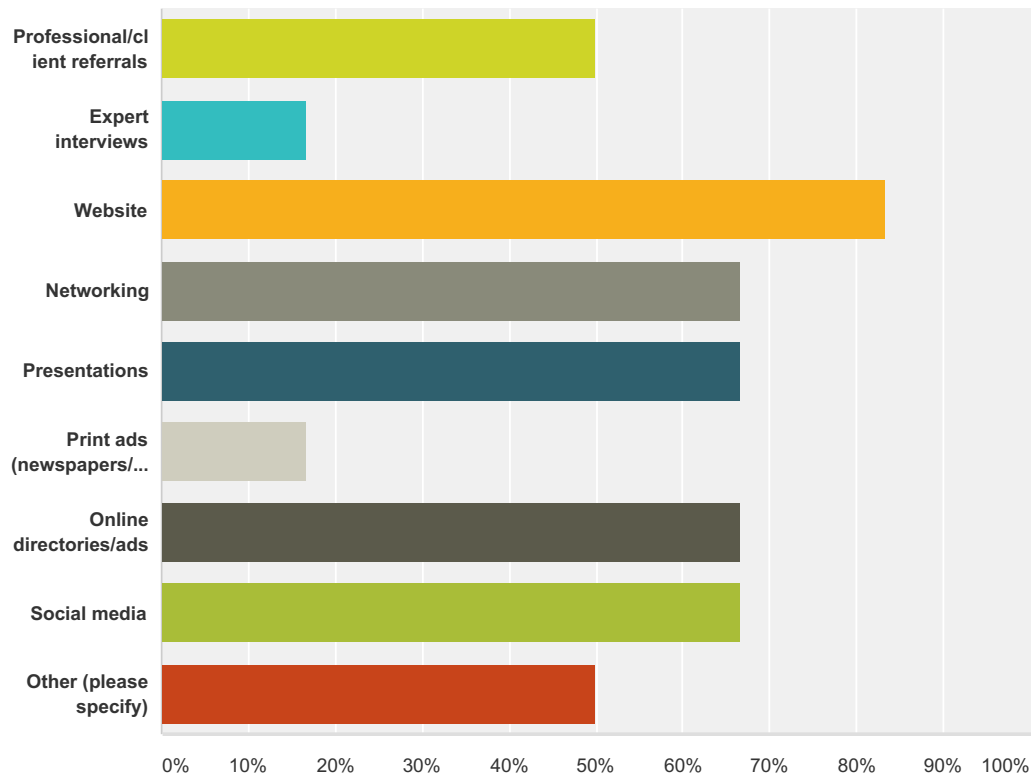

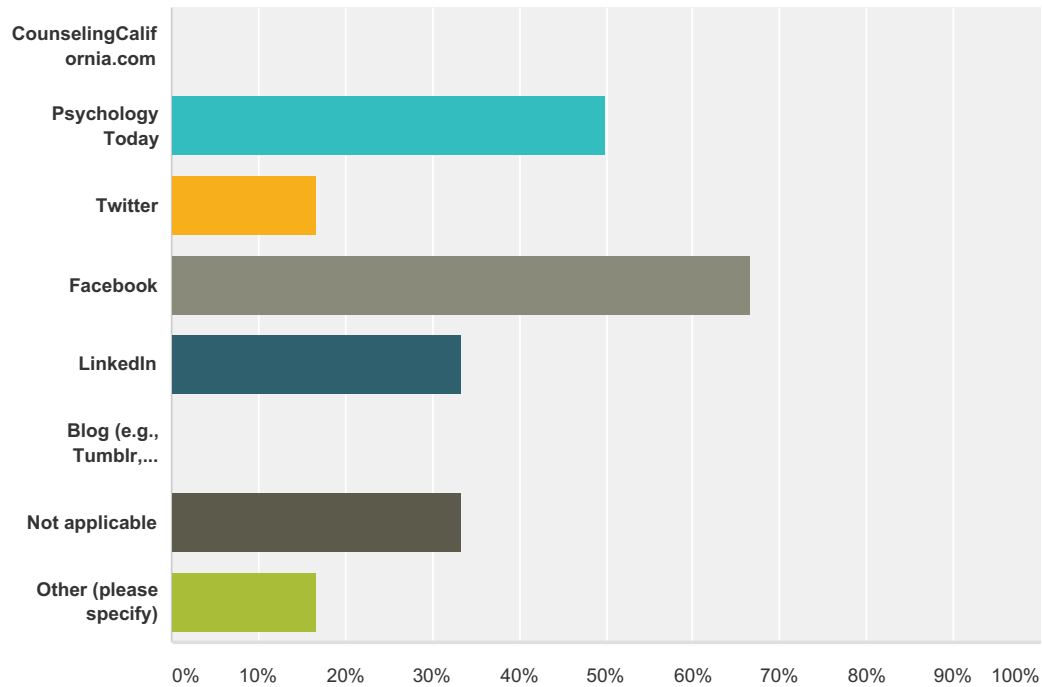

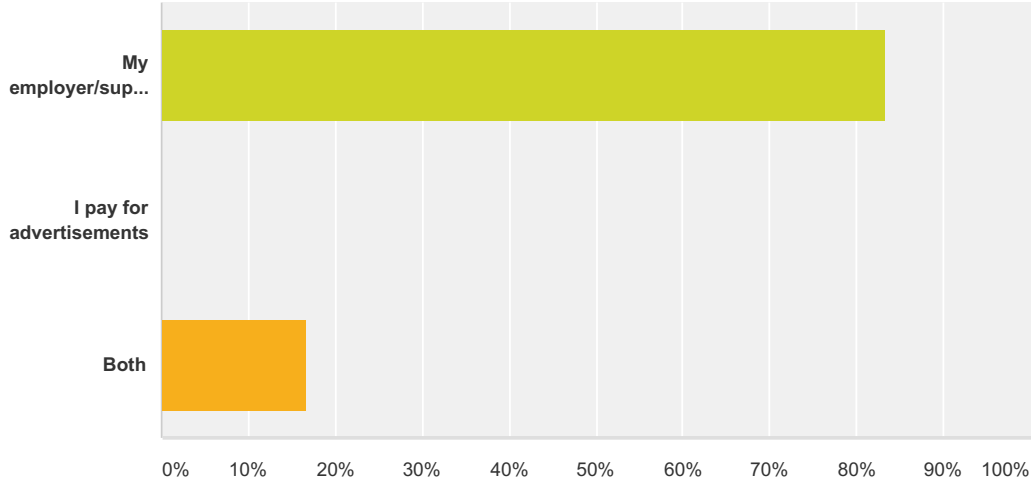

Q57 Are the advertisements paid for by your employer/supervisor or do you pay for them?

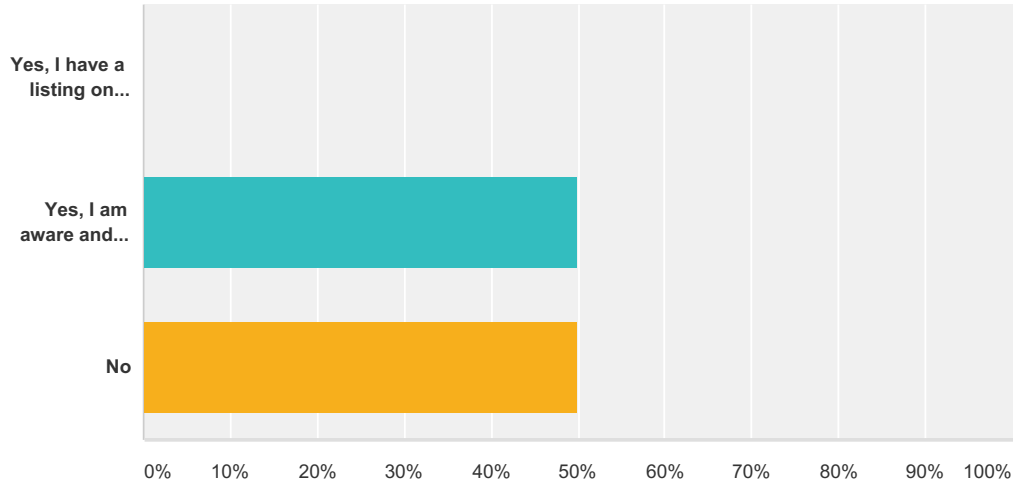

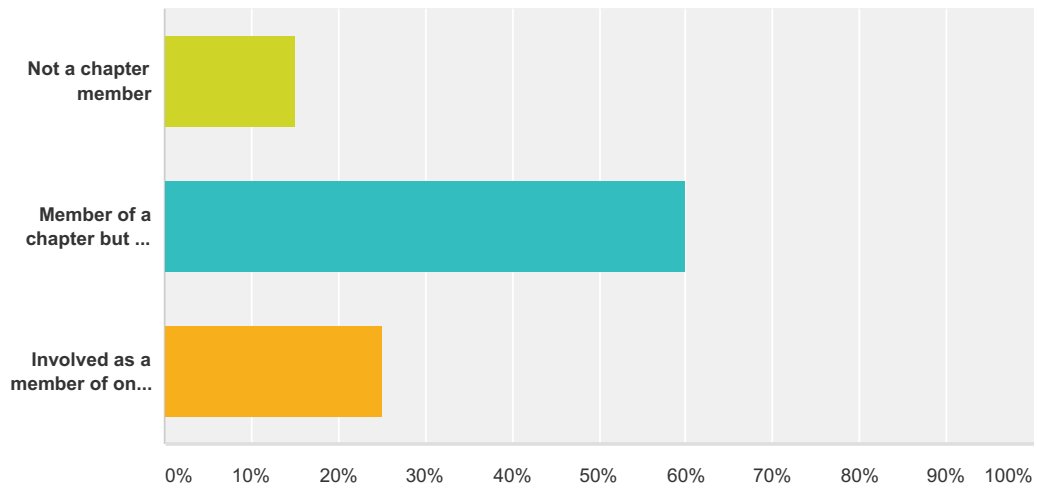

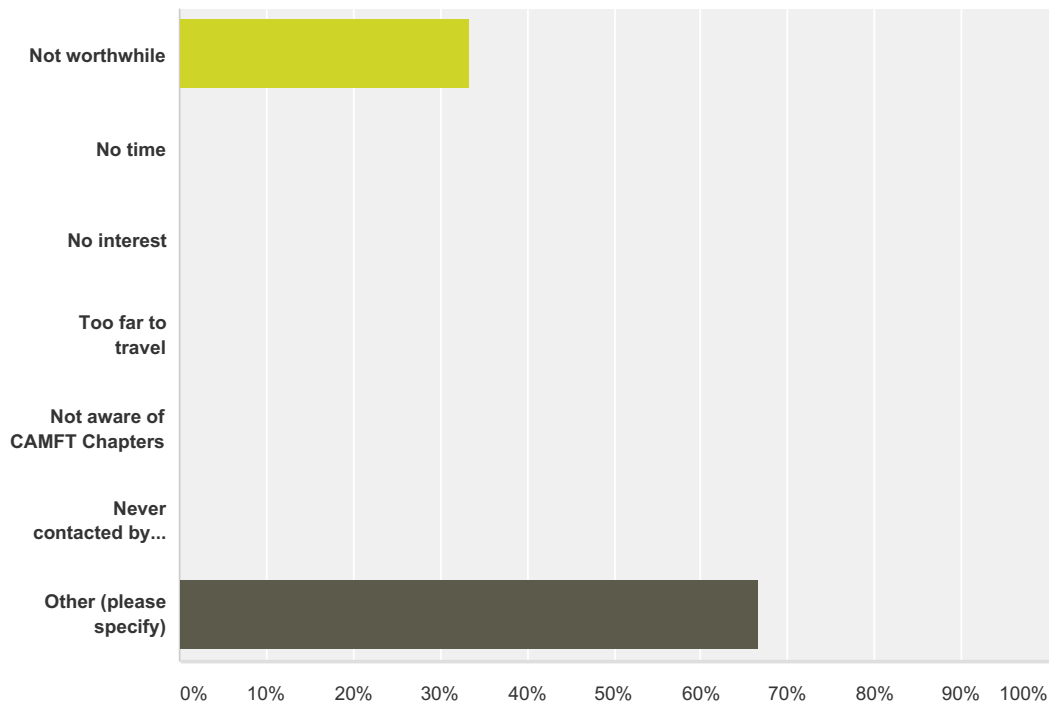

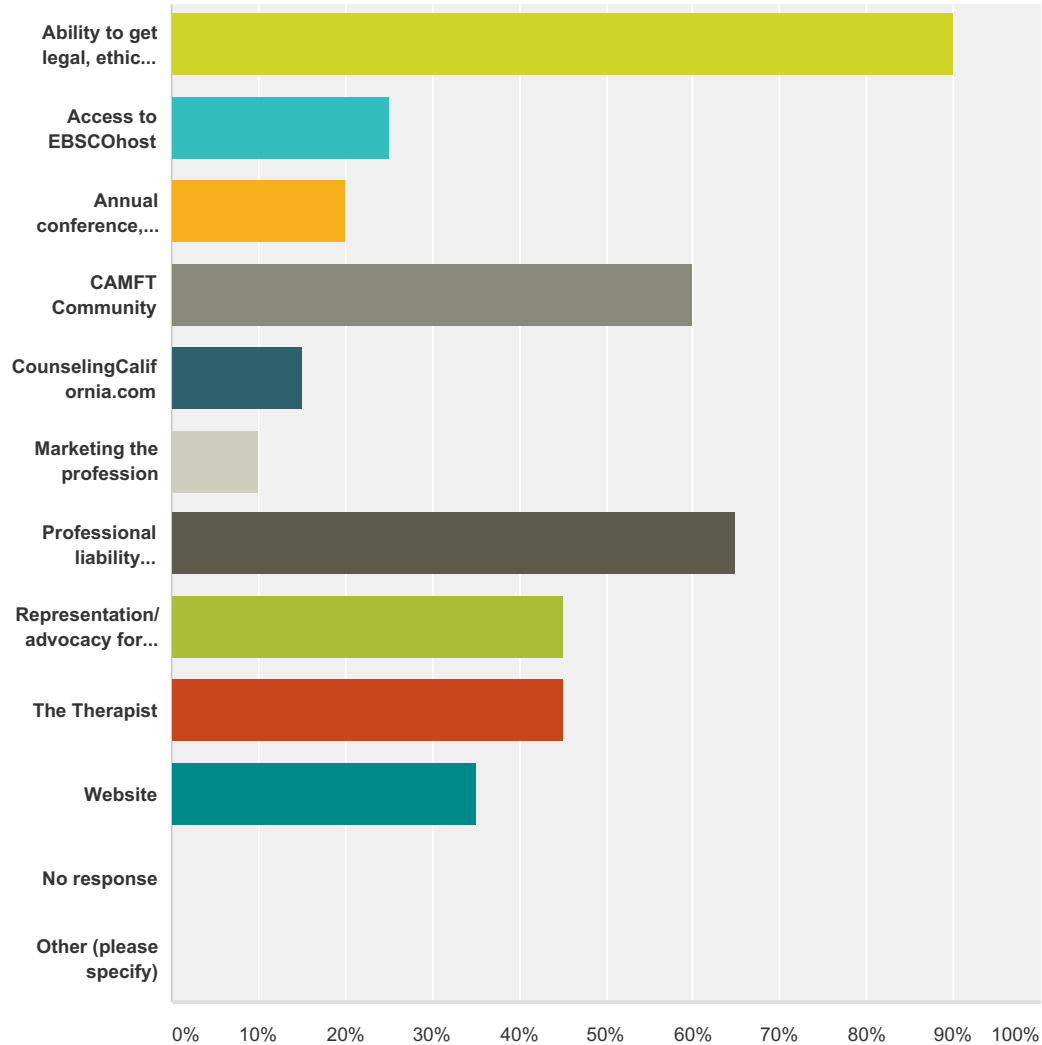
