Dr. Ronald D. Lunceford, an LMFT and clinical hypnotherapist, was actively involved in advancing the marriage and family therapy profession. He had special interests in gerontology, human relations, death and dying, minority concerns and political action. His efforts in these areas resulted in his becoming actively involved with CAMFT where he served as co-chair of the Minority Concerns Committee, participated in the Human Rights Network, was elected to the Board of Directors of CAMFT, became President and served as chair of the Nominating Committee. His clinical practice was highlighted by his founding of the People's Clinic in Santa Ana and the Irvine Counseling Center. His publications include: *Living and Dying - Expression of Life in Transition through Art and Poetry* and *Attitudes in Death and Dying: A Cross-Cultural View*.
